Other Projects

Everything is Still: Photographers Working in Motion Picture Film

Conceptualizing and curating the upcoming group exhibition. Will run summer 2019 at the Wilson Museum at the Southern Vermont Art Center, Manchester Vermont. Show will feature approximately twenty photographers' works of varying size and subject matter, a 45 minute original documentary, and *Back From the "Dead,"* a panel discussion of film photography today.

Visiting Artist, Spring 2019. Burr and Burton Academy, Manchester, VT. Worked with students to produce a one minute movie made with 35mm camera film.

Photography Teacher and Mentor, 2000- present. Classes are taught in my Vermont studio and on location around the world. Yearlong individualized lesson plans focus on student goals and areas of interest, from all different areas and aspects of the medium.

About Eve O. Schaub

Eve O. Schaub is an internationally published author and speaker. Her first book, *Year of No Sugar*, (2014, Sourcebooks) enjoyed widespread acclaim including being featured on the Dr. Oz show, Fox and Friends, *USA Today*, *The Huffington Post*, *The Boston Globe*, *The Denver Post*, *The New York Daily News*, *Everyday Health*, and the Yahoo homepage, among many others. It continues to sell steadily nationwide.

Internationally, *Year of No Sugar* has received coverage from countries such as Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Colombia, Mexico, New Zealand, Ireland and Qatar. Film crews have come from all over the world to interview Schaub and her family from Russia, France, Korea, and Saudi Arabia, most notably Ahmed Alshugari's show *Khawatir*, which aired during Ramadan and enjoyed viewership of over 15 million people. The book has been published as an e-book, in an audio version, and has been translated into Chinese, Hebrew, and Spanish. Schaub's online article for *Everyday Health* about her family's *Year of No Sugar* has to date been liked on various social media over a million times.

Kirkus Reviews wrote that *Year of No Sugar* is "A funny, intelligent and informative memoir." In the article "The 6 Paperbacks We're Reading Now," *FIRST for Women* associate editor Melissa Sorrells wrote, "I certainly learned a lot about the benefits of reducing sugar, but the best part was how much I laughed!"

Schaub's second book *Year of No Clutter* (2017, Sourcebooks) was selected as the *Best Decluttering Advice of 2017* by MindBodyGreen.org and by Bustle as one of the *20 Best Nonfiction Books Coming in March 2017*. Booklist called *Year of No Clutter*, "A personal and powerful read," and *Kirkus Reviews* described it as "Part memoir and part how-to guide... a wry account of the author's quest to 'pitch plunder recycle and sell.'" Bay State Parent Magazine called it "incredibly funny (and) relatable." *Year of No Clutter* is also available in e-book and audio book formats.

Currently Eve and her husband, acclaimed artist Stephen Schaub are collaborating on a new series of artworks that combine monumental, in-camera collage on film imagery with handwritten creative and historical writings.

Eve O. Schaub is a graduate of both Cornell University (BA, BFA) and the Rochester Institute of Technology (MFA). She lives with her family in Vermont.
