

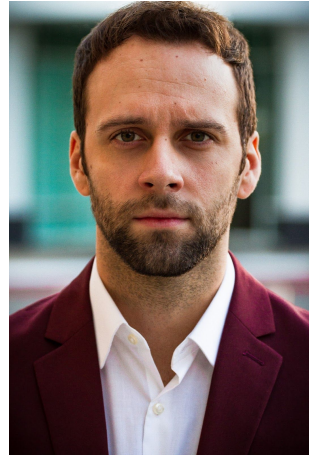

Crime Thriller Short Film

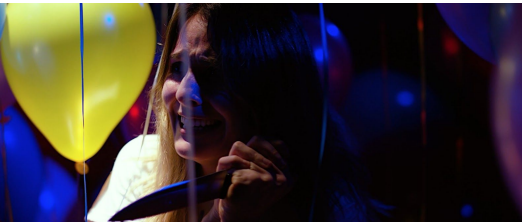
*Upon breaking and entering into a home in the suburbs of the San Fernando Valley, our silent felon finds that all is not what it seems in this modern noir crime thriller.*

## **“Mama’s Boys” (Historical Drama)**

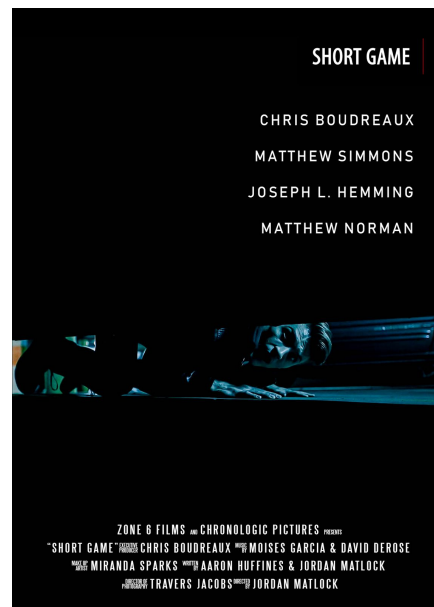
