I was a lecturer and mentor to Mitchell Bulfin for the Studio 2 unit. In that time, Mitchell earned the roles of DoP and colourist demonstrating well-developed technical and transferable skills in the production of a documentary from concept to festival release.

He has a keen interest in and natural aptitude for technical skills such as camera operation and colour grading using da Vinci Resolve. He was also proactive in honing these skills to a professional level with cognitive outsourcing and deliberate practice.

Of particular note are his transferable skills of communication, acting as a team player, seeking as well as implementing critical feedback to improve each version of the edit and colour grade.
