Steve Vasiliou views life as a journey full of movement, learning and experiences. Born and raised in Ohio, his first borrowed book from a library at age five was an illustrated guide to Argentina. Now living in Greece for many years, a thirst for knowledge continues to this day even after a BA Honor's degree in International Relations, an MPhil in Peace Studies from Trinity College, Ireland, Diplomas in different fields, and fluency in six languages.

Writing and photography skills helped fuel a freelance career in journalism which resulted in three photography awards and author distinctions. Studies include screenwriting and filmmaking courses. In 2017 to 2021, Steve received 144 official selections and awards for his projects from international film festivals.

A book with over sixty short stories titled "Geotravel Tips and Stories" by Steve Vasiliou was published on July 31, 2021. Available in all formats, this book has so far received excellent reviews. Three new novels are being completed at the moment.

One of these is "Haus Pandora" a comedy genre book based on Steve's similarly titled award-winning short screenplay.
