Logline: A young lady's visions brings her to Camp Forest Green during a Day of the Dead Celebration, while she seeks answers, her and other campers are preyed upon by apparitions and a mysterious blood-thirsty killer.

"All Souls Day" is written along the lines of films like "The Sixth Sense" and "Friday the 13th". The story is about a clairvoyant named Alice who struggles with and is determined to confront her visions. Her most recent visions bring her to Camp Forest Green during a Day of the Dead Weekend Celebration. While most of Alice's friends are unaware of such visions nor her abilities, her friends have kept secrets and resentments of their own. After settling in at camp, an apparition immediately appears to Alice and warns her of an evil presence. Later in the evening, Camp Director Alfred shares a legend around the campfire. Legend has it, during a storm near the turn of the century, a few hunters not only spilled blood of a sacred animal on an Indian burial ground nearby but became possessed, tortured, and fed on fellow hunter William Wilkenson. Wilkenson took his vengeance, became possessed himself, and his spirit is rumored to roam the woods of Camp Forest Green ever since. After the campfire, Alfred stays behind and is murdered by a mysterious and blood thirsty killer.

The next morning, Alice awakes from a nightmare about a couple who was killed many years prior at Camp Forest Green, who forewarns Alice of her pending doom. Later in the afternoon, as campers decorate masquerade masks, they are watched upon by apparitions of the same couple who were murdered years prior. As resentments flare among the girls and sexual tension heightens between the sexes, campers separate into pairs. While separated, campers prepare for an evening celebration and become intimate with one another as they are stalked by apparitions and a mysterious killer. Meanwhile, Alice and Camp Counselor Sean both head to Wilkenson's lodge to find Alfred where he resides as Alice admits of her current and past premonitions. While at the lodge, an apparition appears and whispers to Alice not to trust anyone.

Once Alice and Sean return to camp, bloodshed starts, and bodies quickly pile up. As distrust divides, secrets and resentments are revealed among best friends, and everyone becomes a suspect. Now, with time running out, Alice must uncover the truth and confront her visions once and for all and face the mysterious killer who is revealed as the supernatural force known as William Wilkenson. Or if Alice does not confront Wilkenson, spirits from his victims will never be at peace and Wilkenson will continue to prey on campers and roam the woods of Camp Forest Green forever.

Finally, after killing William Wilkenson, Alice awakes the next day on All Souls Day. History repeats itself as Alice is stranded in a storm with no escape. Alice becomes possessed and prepares herself to feed on the corpses which surround her. I believe confronting one's fears will appeal to a wide audience. I received consultation from Amazon Studios Script Analyst Michael Schulman who believes not only All Souls Day can be the next great horror franchise but believes William Wilkenson will become the next horror icon!

“All Souls Day works because of how it structures its plot and delivers the pacing. In a narrative with the many twist and turns, the slow drip of information and the feel of escalation is the key. This script manages both well, tantalizing the reader with more gripping scenes right away to capture attention and pose the central questions of the narrative. We later get the introduction to the world of normalcy and the hero’s setup, but the opening moments know how to capture the tone and hint at the concept. Hint might be a bit generous because the writer is eager to introduce the main killer. But motivations remain hidden. We discover secrets and the deeper mysteries alongside characters, and there always seem to be some dangling carrot of information to drag the whole story forward. There are still the opportunities to guess at future plot points with clues scattered about, but I suspect most readers won’t see the bigger reveals coming.

I found myself excited to read his script because the writer does a wonderful job at escalating the tension and delivering new information in a measured manner. Though the first 10 pages are where we get to understand a script in broad strokes, the writer managed to inject a variety of personalities, goals, and worldview throughout the entire script to keep the narrative evolving and gradually complicating. The writer flirts with number of tones keeping the reader on their toes. By the end we have a very intricate story that kept clear with our understanding of the characters and their goals.

Though the premise isn’t world shattering, the idea of a crazed killer is a classic for a reason. The writer hits all the appropriate beats expected of the genre while introducing characters with a gift for gab. I liked the new elements added, but quickly fell into a comfortable groove when reading this as it clearly understands the genre its operating in.” NYC International Screenplay Awards.
