# Q&A

## Melanie Gretchen – Executive Producer, Writer, Assistant Director



### **What was your inspiration for the film?**

When my friend had offered her garden for the film, I thought about how differences may be small but grow and become more obvious over time.

For the most part, the characters, like the garden, look the same, but in their love triangle, the differences between their expectations and reality are magnified by the confines of the garden.

### **What were the major obstacles?**

The weather was a challenge. The garden was covered, and we shot in April 2023, but it was almost all outside, so 12 hours in cool weather felt cold, and spring showers disrupted the first day.

### **What was your favorite part of production?**

I loved developing the script with the director, Pat Bradley, and the principal actors, Bryan Harlow and Ryan Wesen.

The story had started as a romantic drama, then slowly settled into a psychological thriller, which shifted all the casting and acting choices - and we had three rehearsals before the two days for filming, so we had time to discuss the characters and explore their relationships.
