# SYNOPSIS

Women of Pinot explores how these trailblazing women have shaped and developed the region's thriving wine industry. Despite representing only a small fraction of Willamette Valley's approximately 736 wineries, Women Winemakers have proven themselves to be fearless in their pursuit of excellence in Oregon's wine industry. Utilizing resourcefulness, daring and innovation they have broken barriers and have set new standards for quality in wine as newcomers or part of already established wineries. Through sheer will and determination, these winemakers continue to be a growing and influential force.

# OUR STORY

The idea for the Women of Pinot wine documentary began in early 2020 during conversations with local winemakers about the notable presence of women winemakers in Oregon, particularly in the Willamette Valley, the heart of Oregon Pinot Noir. It was surprising to learn that, despite the valley being home to over 730 wineries, less than 9% are led by women winemakers. We immediately recognized this as a story that needed to be told.
