

'Fatal Negligence' Exposes Terrifying Elder Care Scam

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A gripping new short film, Fatal Negligence exposes a horrific reality that millions of vulnerable adults and their family members have reported experiencing across America.

The narrative follows Georgina Dillard, a devoted daughter desperate to protect her elderly father, Ben Dillard, a partially blind retired military veteran.

Held against his will at an assisted living facility, Ben is being isolated, neglected, systemically starved and deprived of adequate medical care, including a prescription he needs to treat glaucoma.

Georgina turns to investigator Larry Limine who goes undercover to find out why Ben is being denied visits with his daughter.

This 22-minute dramatic thriller was directed by Juliette Fairley and filmed in downtown Manhattan. It highlights the predatory dark side of the elder care industry.

The film stars Fairley as Georgina Dillard, Ajene D. Washington as Ben Dillard, and Behzad Dabiri as the investigator who tries to help. Actors who played the staff in the assisted living facility include Marie Donna Davis and Deborah Bevins.

Fatal Negligence is a timely, heart-wrenching exposé that masterfully blends the tension of a crime thriller with an urgent call to action regarding human rights and legal reform.

The project aims to amplify the voices of exploited military veterans and other victims of unconstitutional court-appointed probate guardianships and conservatorships nationwide. ###
