About Me & Director's Statement



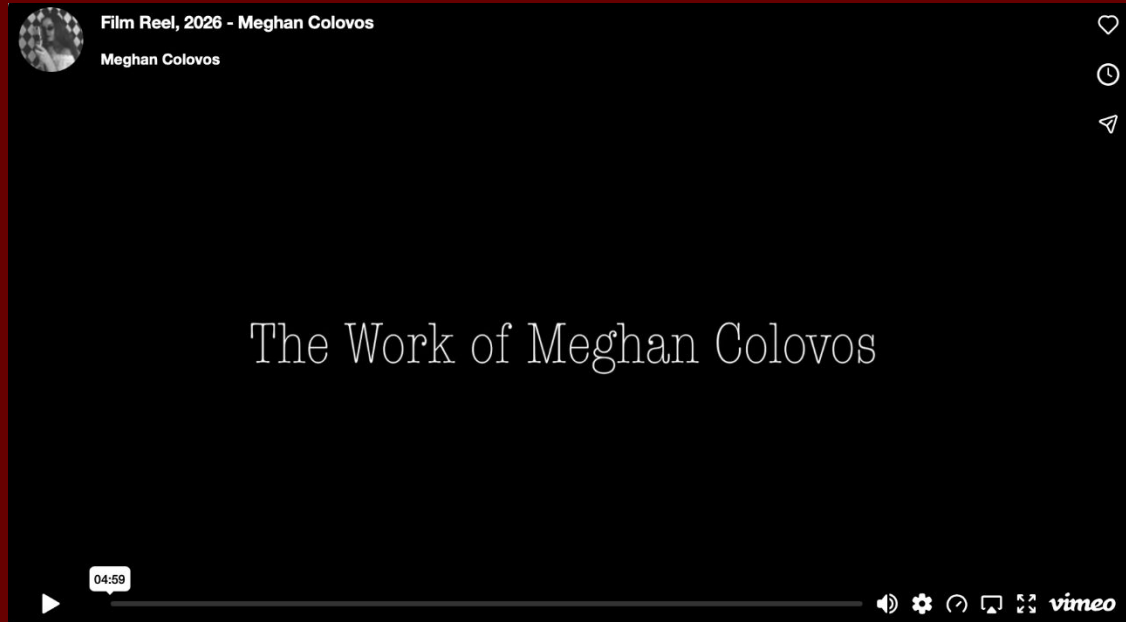

Meghan's work has screened in film festivals such as The Washington West Film Festival (2025 and 2026), the Los Angeles Film and Documentary Awards Film Festival (2026) where she received the Best Student Film Award for *When The Rain Stopped*, and REELPoetry Film Festival in Houston, Texas (2026). Meghan's work is known for being stylized, heartwarming, relatable, nostalgic, and visually appealing. Meghan graduated from George Mason University in 2026 with a B.A. in Film and Video Studies, with a concentration in Directing, and a minor in English.

- *When The Rain Stopped* (2024) was my debut film as a filmmaker and film student.
- *When The Rain Stopped* is an experimental short film & visual poem film based on a poem I wrote which centers around themes of anxiety and overcoming those emotions. This film was featured in George Mason University's Best of Film at Mason Film Festival and has screened at the Washington West Film Festival and other community spaces in the DMV (D.C., Maryland, Virginia) area. It was also accepted into the 2026 Los Angeles Film and Documentary Awards Film Festival, where it received the Best Student Film Award, and has been accepted into and recognized by many other Film Festivals as well.
- On this set, I worked as Director, Writer, Production Designer, Costuming, and Executive Producer.
- **Synopsis:** A young woman visually represents a poem, discussing the struggles of anxiety and her reconciliation with herself at the end, through an interpretive performance.

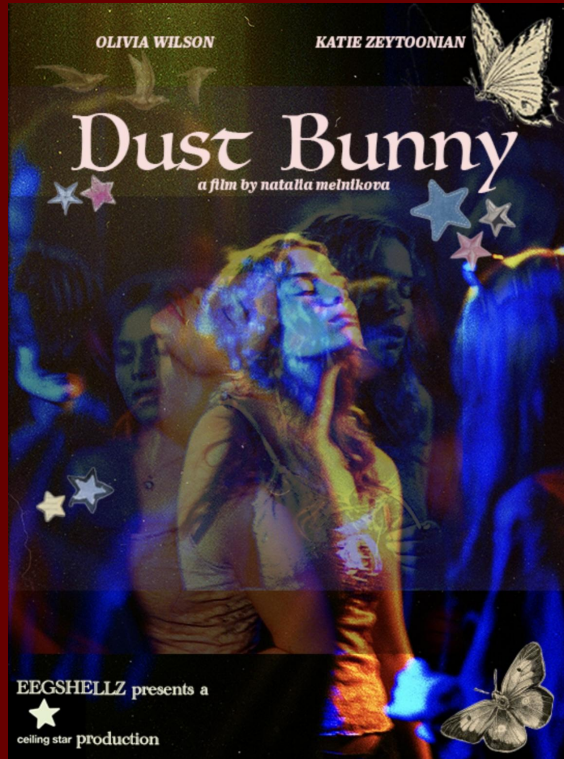

- *Μέλι (Honey)* (2026) is my second film as a film student in the roles of Writer & Director.
- On this set, I worked as Director, Writer, Co-Production Designer, Costuming, and Executive Producer. This film went on to be apart of George Mason University's Best of Film at Mason Film Festival (2026) and The Washington West Film Festival (2026).
- Synopsis: A young woman, who is slowly dying, continues to live her life the same way, every single day. She is always present in the cafe she and her sister own and is always having the same thing: a black tea with honey. When her sister discovers that the young woman doesn't have much time left, she decides to show her a wonderful time by doing the things they love together. Reluctant at first, the young woman eventually gives in to spending a day with her sister, but with her energy depleting, has to find the strength to carry through the day.

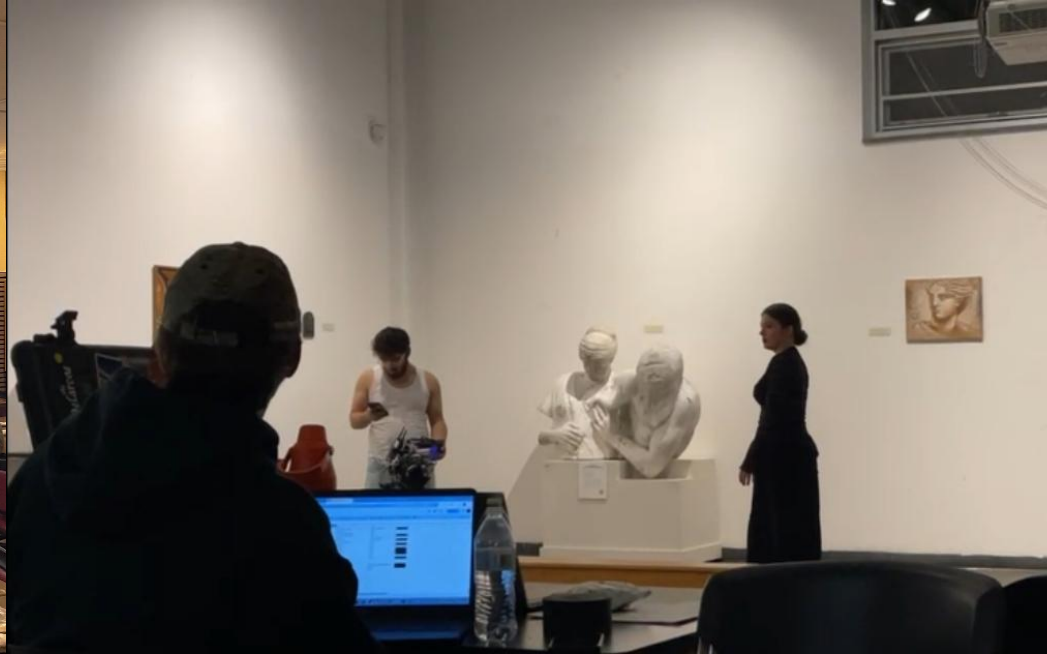

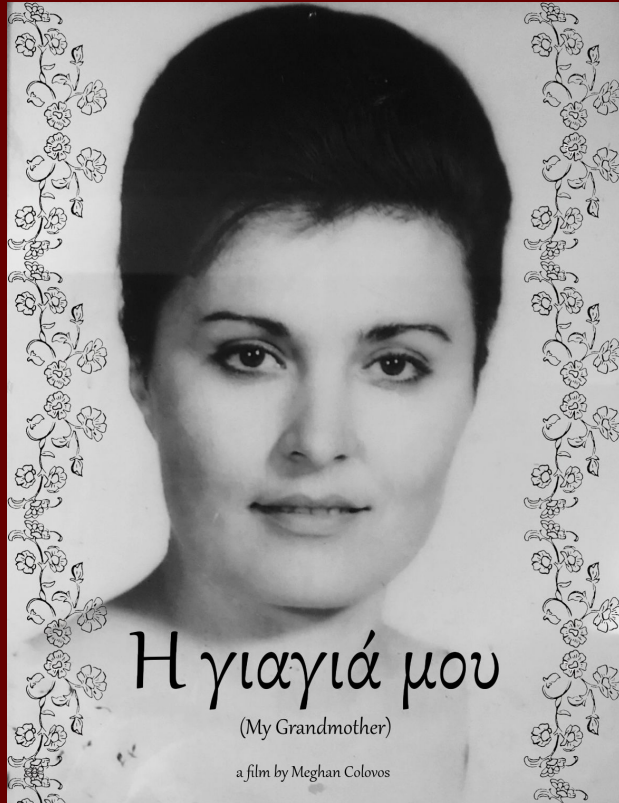

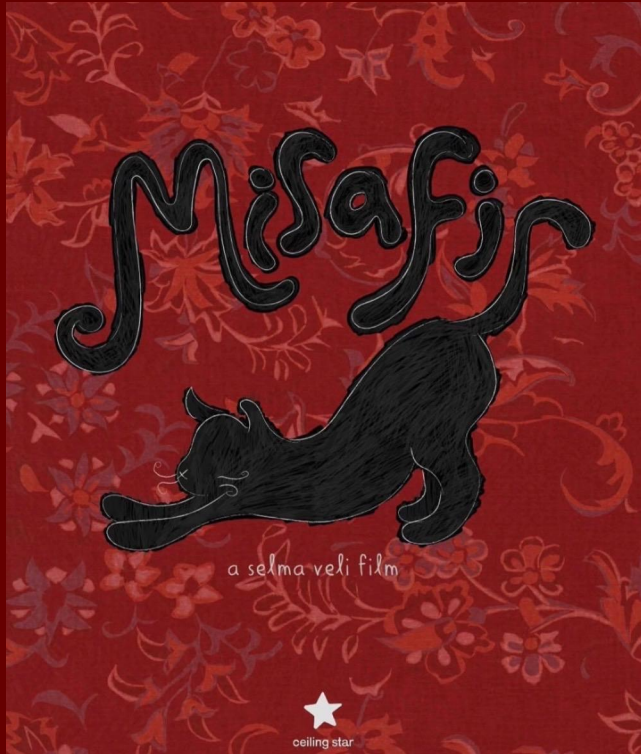

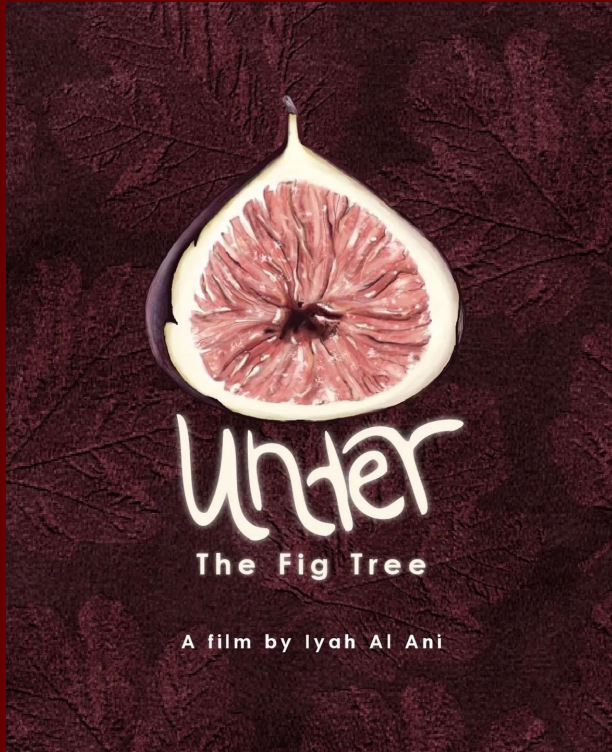

- **Synopsis:** *Under The Fig Tree* tells the story of a young woman who confronts her grief in the form of taking care of a fig tree.

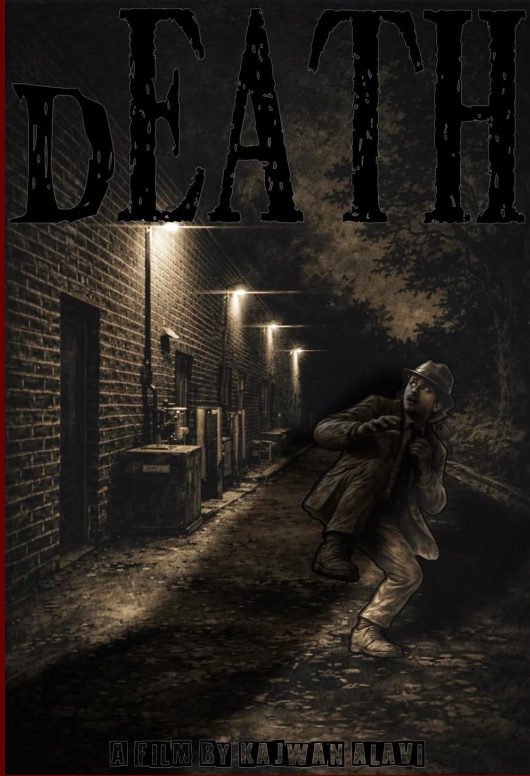
