A documentary about the creative resistance in the Gezi Park protests in Istanbul in 2013.

In May 2013, a growing number of people gathered in Taksim Square in central Istanbul. Provoked by the city's plan to remove Gezi Park, one of the few remaining green spaces in the center of the European side of Istanbul. The demonstrators' response: spontaneous actions in form of concerts, street art and dance.

The documentary gives an insight into the diversity of the Gezi protest movement. The film focuses on the art of the political protest and shows a generation that stands up for their rights, beginning to formulate their own vision of the future.
