SYNOPSIS

After committing a crime against the newborn son, woman abandons home and family in search of an unknown destination. Do not know who is she, nor the why of such crime. The mystery about this woman is one of the key points of the narrative. In the course of history will be called Maria, Rosa and Ana, may be one of them your real name, may be none. She will walk for a whole day, embraced a watermelon and will brief encounters that will mark her day and her life, facing a world sometimes hostile and sometimes delicate, in the attempt to live together with love and loveless which brings herself.





All the break, from the outset, the thread of life, love truly unconditional said, this woman follows the reverse side. Impregnated with a violence, both suffered as exercised, she is the picture of a female desecrated, with her angels and demons, her pain, her evil and her delicacy. Life lips away by her breast, although she is always in search of its. A being of multiple faces, desires and obscure feelings. The personification of the myth Gaia, the Great Mother who give-and-take, which nourishes and devours her children after death. This film is a delicate and intimate account about the feminine, its dogmas and precepts. A narrative driven by emotion, betting in sequences plans, at work and emotion of the actors, in a simple straight for word camera and breathing along with the characters. A low budget production in which the window of the festivals is indispensable to its visibility in its country and abroad.
