## The Director's Bio

Alejandro was born in Tegucigalpa, the capital of Honduras on September 8, 1974. Ever since he was just a boy, his passion for art was fed by his parents. Their house was always surrounded by music, books and creativity. They fostered his passion by giving instead of toys, the cameras he asked for birthdays and Christmas.

Alejandro started his professional career at 16 years old in advertising, focusing on creativity and production. He moved to Mexico City to study cinematography and visual communication. Alejandro has created, produced and directed more than a dozen of tv shows, a countless amount of TV ads, documentaries and music videos.

Alejandro leads a content and creative boutique (LaPulpe) and a production company, created exclusively for fiction formats (Balam Entertainment) His opera prima a TV pilot in form of a short film "Divine Justice" has earned him several recognitions in awards from all over the world:



Currently Alejandro is working on bringing to the big screen the life of the indigenous resistance hero, the Cacique Lempira.

In October 2017 finished a short film inspired by true events that happen in the 1969 war affair between El Salvador and Honduras: "Flea". Also about this subject, he is producing a documentary about that war mistakenly known as the Soccer War.

Other projects include a satire-comedy feature film on Latin American politics and a TV series inspired by the stories of local famous writer: Carmilla Wyler, the original author of "Divine Justice".
