Luckily, the side job took him back on. Then he booked a recurring role on an MTV show, followed by another show, and another until he was a working actor. Since he's worked on several movies and many TV shows including One Tree Hill, CSI, Lucifer, and is currently recurring on TNT's Major Crimes. You can currently find him on the streets of LA doing research for a role shooting early next year.
