

Short Action Film “The Most Interesting Man in Show Business” Named Selection of Seattle Asian American Film Festival

Knockabout Pictures and writer, director and producer James H. Lee are causing some excitement with the new short action film “The Most Interesting Man in Show Business”, now being selected for screenings including the Seattle Asian American Film Festival taking place February 21-24, 2019.

James H. Lee may have action movie writing and directing in his blood if the enthusiasm surrounding the short film “[The Most Interesting Man in Show Business](#)” is any indication. Produced by his own Knockabout Pictures the short film has been a major cause of interest with its throwback to 70's action film flair and well choreographed fight scenes. Getting major attention from film festivals nationwide, Lee announced they will be presenting at the Seattle Asian American Film Festival February 21-24, 2019, a major win considering the amount of acclaim surrounding the event. Expect attendees to be on the edge of their seats.



“We put a great deal of work and love into 'The Most Interesting Man in Show Business' so it's good to see it paying off,” commented the writer and director. “The characters have huge potential and the screenplay for a full feature is ready-to-go. We have full confidence this will explode beyond a short film.”

According to Lee, some highlights of where “The Most Interesting Man in Show Business” will be shown include the Austin Comedy Short Film Festival taking place September 16 at the Alamo Drafthouse Theater Lakeline, where it has won a nomination for “Best Micro Short Comedy”, also at Boston Asian American Film Festival taking place October 21 at the famous Paramount Theater along with being an official selection of the Urban Action Showcase festival sponsored by HBO/Cinemax taking place November 10 in NYC. Urban Action Showcase also selected Lee's screenplay “The Knockabout Artist”, which is based on the characters from “The Most Interesting Man in Show Business” as a top 10 finalist.
