About The Documentary

KEEP THE FIRE LIT provides a unique insight into the hearts and minds, and the lives of Indigenous Texans—diving deep into this remarkable fragment of Native society. Personal interviews highlight the social, political, and environmental implications of the re-emergence of indigenous identities. Visiting holy sites across Texas and interviewing key individuals from these Native communities: tribal spiritual leaders, peyote road men, cultural artisans, traditional tribal dancers, environmental activists and civil rights lawyers. The film takes us to Standing Rock to stand with Texas Water Protectors and then draws us in, to the first ever Apache Reunion in Ojinaga Mexico.

Lipan Apache, Veteran, Filmmaker, Fox RedSky has completed her first feature film, Keep the Fire Lit - Lost Tribes of Texas. After 3 and half years traveling all over Texas and Parts of Mexico and even making a trip to Standing Rock, North Dakota with her at-the-time 2 year old daughter in tow, she is ready to send her exciting heart felt Documentary to the world.
