

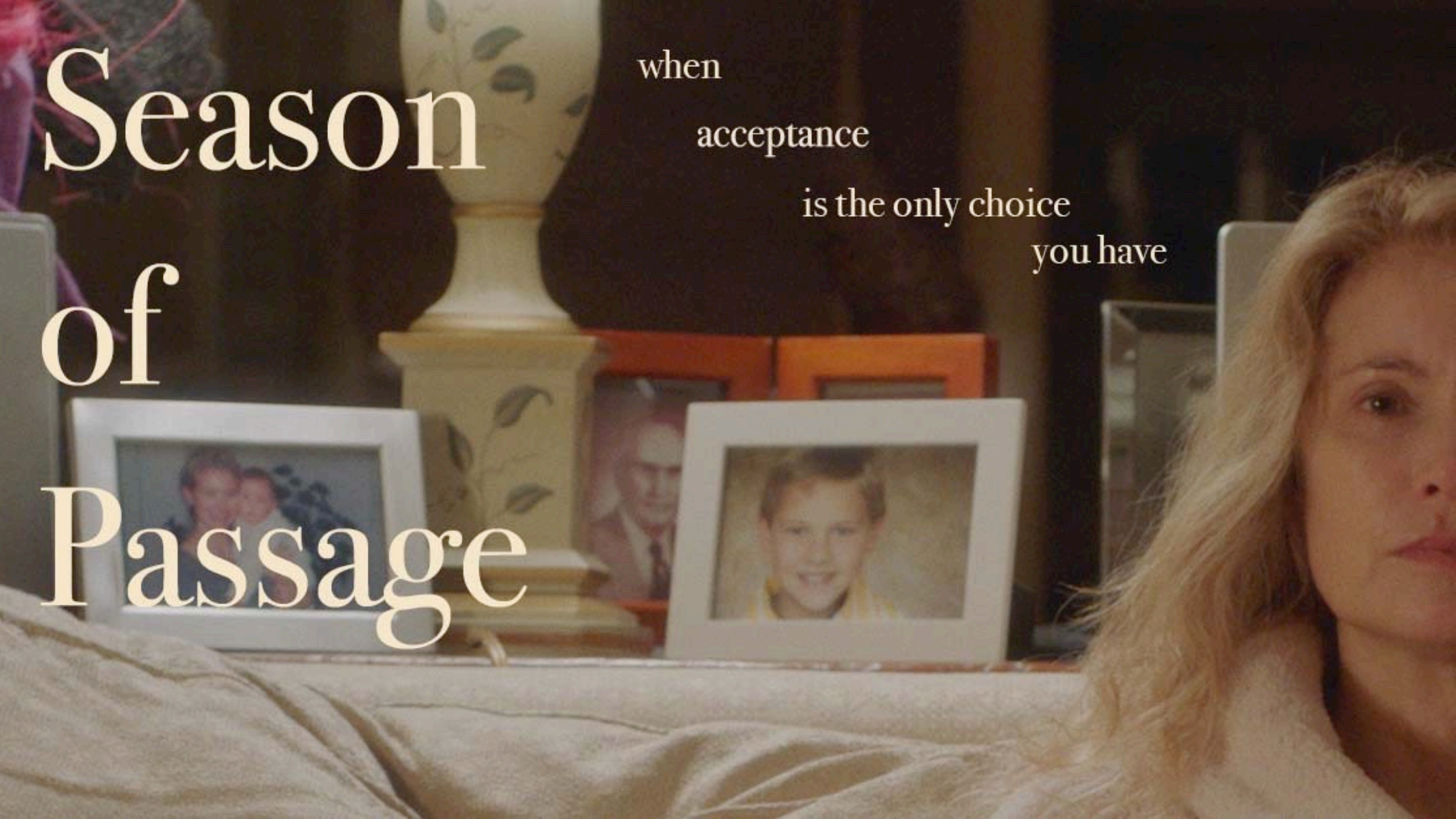

SYNOPSIS

Having long given up on her dream of having another child, she grapples with this new hope. But when Cate suffers a miscarriage, she finds herself in the shoes of countless women, silently grieving a life that will never be.



ABOUT THE FILM

Season of Passage is based on the actual experience of the filmmaker. It is a day in the life of a woman that shows the unseen reality of a miscarriage. Every pregnancy loss is different: it happened at work, a birthday party, the grocery store, the boardroom, in the middle of the night. But all women feel devastating loss.

This film was made to give women something they can watch and feel understood in a flash. When they are unable to find voice to share their experience, they can say to someone, “Please take 15 minutes to watch this film” to help others begin to understand what they have gone, or are going, through.





ABOUT CATHERINE COBB RYAN

Catherine is a NYC based Actor/Filmmaker as well as a busy mother of four. A William Esper Studio and NYU grad, Catherine never imagined making a film until she started sharing her pregnancy loss story with others and was told this was a story that people wanted to see on the screen. She founded Moon Hill Pictures, named after her childhood home, and is now writing her first feature - a story about guns and the generational cycle of violence against women.
