Meanwhile Ramiro, a young Bohemian, walks the streets of Tehuacán, Mexico, with the stray dog Diego in tow. A street artist is painting the Aztec God Tezcatlipoca, a God of mischief and temptation. Ramiro's usual hangout is the Juarez Park, in the company of the dog Diego and the Iguana Olga. People think that Diego may be the re-incarnation of the Aztec God Tezcatlipoca. They both have a stripe across the face. - Miguel's family is poor. He lives with his mother and little sister. The father died in the War ten years ago.



After Miguel gives Rose and her accompanying friend Alice a ride from the Tehuacán train station to the Hotel Peñafiel, he is smitten with Rose and seeks the advice of the barber Alfonso. The barber sends him to the town witch, the Curandera, because Miguel needs a love hex for Rose to fall in love with him.



The love hex seems to work. Miguel hooks up with Rose, and Alice with Ramiro. Eventually, the love games get a little out of control. One night in Alice's hotel room, Ramiro pretends to be Zorro who saves the damsel in distress. When preparations for the Día de los Muertos celebrations are under way, Rose's jealous husband Spencer arrives out of the blue. The confrontation happens during the Día de los Muertos celebrations.



Eventually, Ramiro moves to Mexico City, where he finally meets his idol Agustín Lara—but the encounter does not go the way he had envisioned it.
