Q: How did this show come about?

A: I had some hilariously bad dates when I first turned to online dating, some where I LITERALLY fell flat on my face because my boots locked together, others where my date metaphorically fell flat on their face, like the date in Episode One. Everyone has these battle stories. Similarly, I was fascinated why online dating was so hard. I started to do some research and some years later after partnering with Yaroslav Altunin, the thing got legs!

Q: What is the NYC Women in Film, Theatre, and TV Fund?

A: It's a wonderful grant available to female creators presented by the New York Foundation for the Arts, the NYC Mayor's Office, and the NYC Film Commissioner's Office. Womxn, APPLY! They now accept applications for music projects too.

Q: How did you raise additional funds?

A: We raised an additional \$7000 on IndieGogo and \$1200 from our fiscal sponsorship with Fractured Atlas. What a giving community we have! We couldn't have done it without them.

Q: How many people were involved in the show?

A: 40 total people. That's cast, crew, pre- and post-production staff. Not including stunts. (Just kidding, we didn't do that.)

Q: The whole cast seems to have really great chemistry. Were you all friends before? How was the rehearsal process with the actors?

A: Sarah and Yaro knew a few of the actors through mutual connections, and the first day filming our teaser with the four lead actors, the chemistry was electric! Sarah used to live in NYC, so she knew a few of the actors like Zina Wilde, Brian Patrick Murphy, and Amy Jo Jackson. Wunmi and Adenike are also recipients of the Grant, and we became acquaintances. But the others we got extremely lucky! Such skill! Such grace! So proud of everyone's hard work and hilarity.
