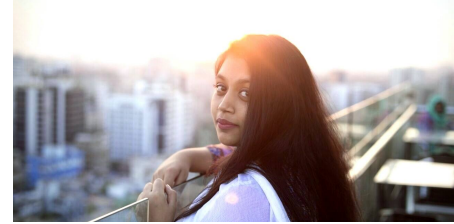
Animator, Abdul Ela
