Work alone or collaborate with friends (18 years or younger).	Entries are to be submitted via filmfreeway.com .
Limit one entry per person or group.	A one-hour program will be curated from all eligible submissions.
Running time: 5 minutes or less.	First, Second, Third and Audience Favorite prizes will be awarded.
No film trailers or pre-formatted templates.	Entry deadline is January 15, 2021. All juror decisions are final.
