Andres Castillo, is an actor born in the Dominican Republic. After the age of 10, he began attending boarding schools in the United States every few years returning home for a year or so. In the US he attended schools in New Hampshire and Connecticut, increasing his already proficient knowledge of the english language. He graduated with honors from The Gunnery School in Washington, Connecticut and went on to attend Northeastern University where he graduated Cum Laude with a BA in English with a thesis focusing on 'Human Nature' and 'The Portrayal of Characters in Acting.'

After graduation, Andres returned to the Dominican Republic where he began work immediately as an American Literature teacher in the Americas Bicultural School, grades pre-k through 12, in Santo Domingo. After one year as a teacher, he worked as a salesman for several companies and finally as a stock broker in his own trading firm. After some time, Andres decided it was time to focus on his dream and passion of becoming an actor. He sold his company to his partner at the time and began auditioning for small/ extra roles in commercials. He starred in a few commercials as well as secondary roles in Dominican films and then, in 2018, he landed his first leading role in the film "Ain't Facil" directed by renowned Dominican Director, Juan Basanta. Andres has since starred in several Dominican films as either the protagonist or in a leading secondary role and his career and proficiency as an actor has grown exponentially over the years. He has 4 or 5 films being released in 2021 and 2 films, so far, in which he will act as the protagonist during this same year. He has since expanded his repertoire to include music, and has been the host of the number 1 comedy podcast in the Dominican Republic, Lenguas Calvas, for the past 2 years.
