## LOGLINE

After a storm wreaks havoc over a small town in Georgia, a writer on a deadline makes an ominous discovery in the backyard of his rural vacation rental.

## ARTISTIC STATEMENT

LOST/FOUND is a new short form anthology series that bends genre while staying tonally grounded within the vein of dark comedy. The show lifts up a Southern Gothic aesthetic, placing magical realism, dark humor, and a literary sensibility at its center. Season 1 finds its footing in the realm of supernatural and psychological horror.

In each new season, a different object will be lost/found. The series is thematically concerned with how the arrival of strange new objects throws an unsuspecting person's life into disarray, but it's also preoccupied with the particular anxiety of losing things of great personal value. LOST/FOUND aims to blend the high-concept narrative stylings of THE TWILIGHT ZONE and ROOM 104 with the idiosyncratic humor and atmospheric excellence of character-driven shows like ATLANTA and HIGH MAINTENANCE.

## DIRECTOR/PRODUCER, **BRIAN CHRISTOPHER WHITE**

Brian Christopher White is the Director of *LOST/FOUND* and a graduate of the Art Institute of Atlanta. He's most often drawn to stories with a sci-fi or supernatural bent. As the founder of Outjogging Pictures, he has written and directed multiple award-winning short films including *PARKED*, *HELIUM*, *CIRCLES*, *THE BECOWING*, and *DAY IN THE LIFE OF A FLY*. 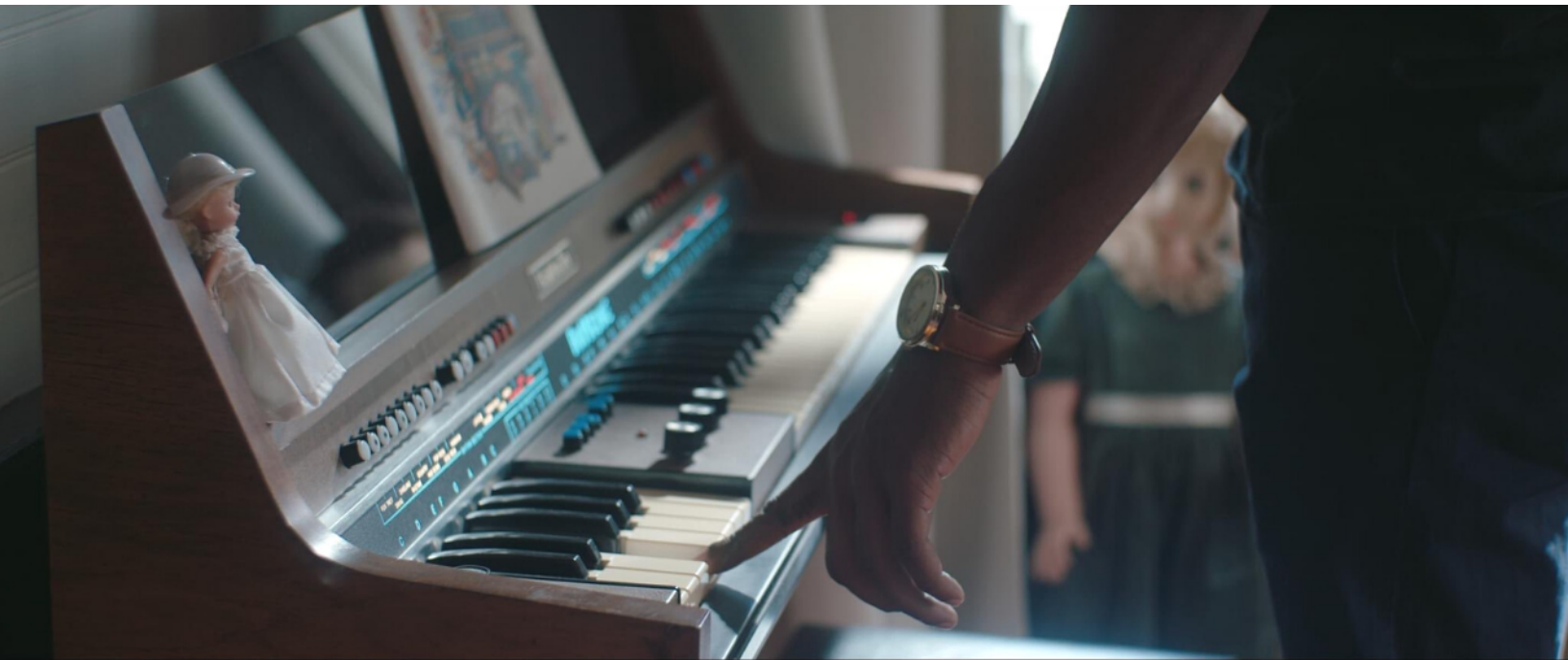
