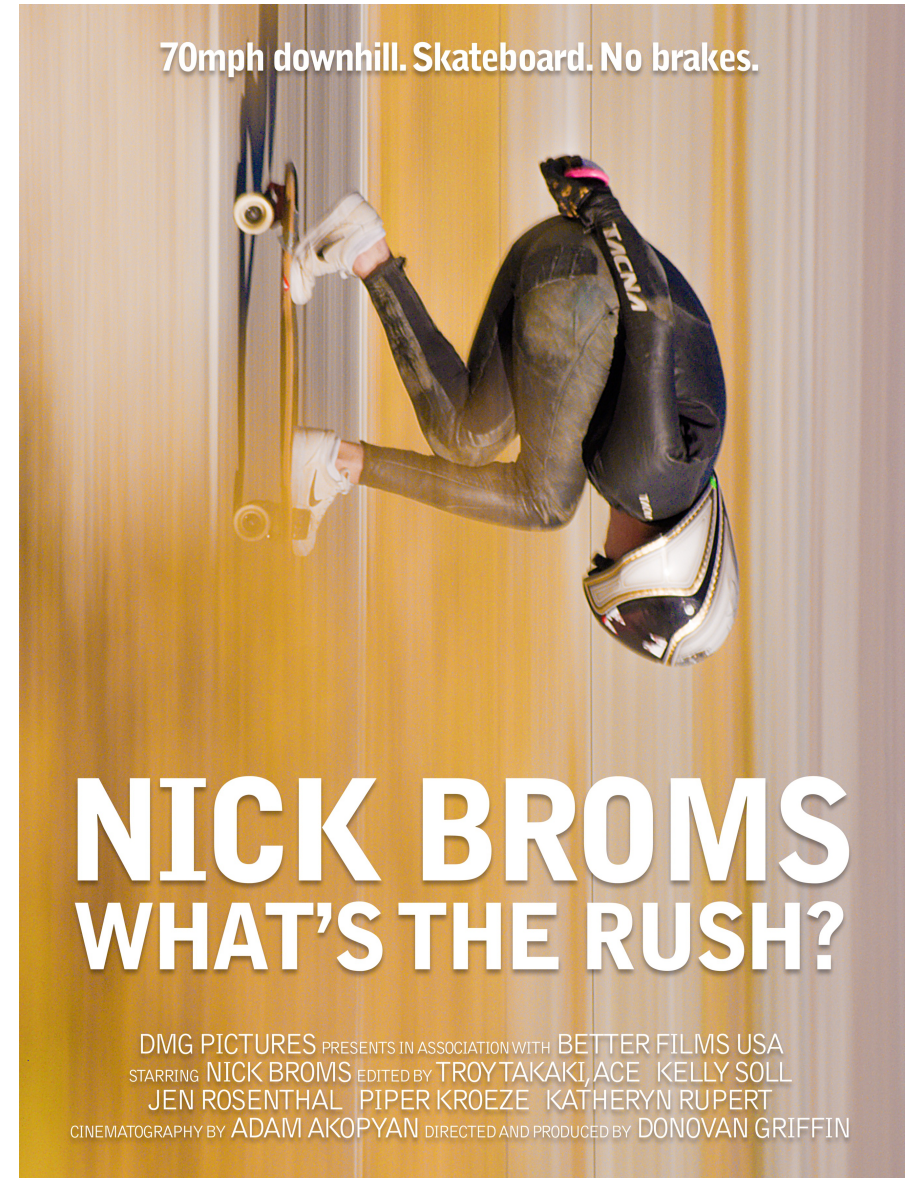


NICK BROMS: WHAT'S THE RUSH?

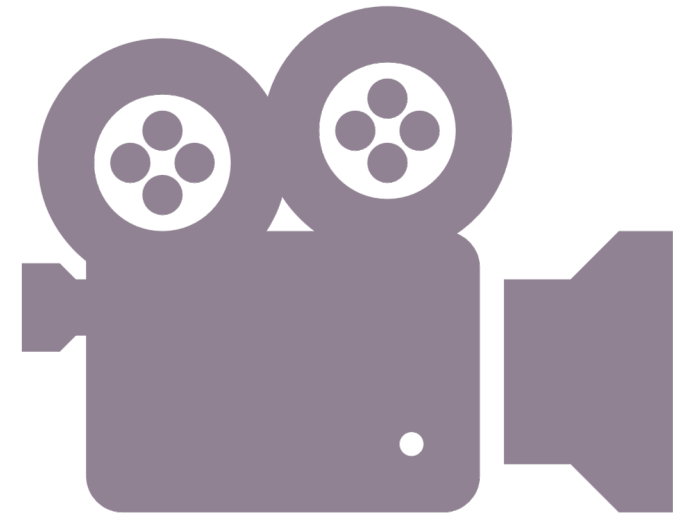
