SYNOPSIS

Marcus and Ava are a fun-loving southern couple from Houston, TX. He's a former amateur boxer turned construction foreman, and she's a devoted, independent nurse, and together they are madly in love.

Marcus took his first loss by KO on the regional circuit and was in a pretty dark place when he bumped into Ava at the grocery store.

Ava herself was grieving the loss of her beloved father (who was a boxer back in the day) But, after five years, they are both wondering what the next step is in their relationship. Marcus has loved nothing or anyone more than boxing. He loves Ava with all of his heart. He wonders to himself if he will fail at marriage like he did at boxing.

Ava is eager to become "Mrs. Marcus Edwards," but every time getting engagement comes up, he becomes uptight and changes the subject, leaving her to question if he thinks that she's the "One".

Marcus, who was surprised by his own actions, started saving for an engagement ring six months ago while also waiting in line to be promoted to management at his construction work. He comes up with the ideal surprise proposal, but as the big moment approaches, he gets nervous and things go wrong.

After sending Ava on a romantic scavenger hunt throughout his apartment, she discovers that the surprise proposal isn't the proposal that she was hoping for.

They must now decide whether to call it quits or separate.

Director Statement



The first concept that came to mind when I first began thinking of ideas for this short film was “Black Love”.

My two all-time favorite TV shows, I Love Lucy and Martin, were the first ideas that came to me when I started brainstorming, so I combined them to make something wholesome and with a 90s retro feel.

Additionally, I want to honor my southern roots by creating characters from Houston, Texas. Most of this couple’s story takes place in each of their apartments, thus we created two distinct set designs in 2 separate apartment locations.

The photographs of legendary heavyweight boxing legends serve as a reflection of how Marcus, a lightweight, views himself.

Ava’s apartment to have a positive, laid-back feeling that sort of reflected her personality as a compassionate person (she works as a nurse), as well as charka stones, inspirational wall art, and images of her and Marcus to show how devoted she is to this relationship.

One challenge I faced while working on this movie was how to bring the audience to Texas while filming in Washington State.

With the help of B-roll and music, we overcame this difficulty. In order to generate a Southern atmosphere, we shot in several Burien, Washington locations. Our Score Armand” A-hop” Hopkins did a fantastic job of producing music that has a southern hip-hop jazz vibe.

We also shot the film in 4K for two reasons: first, we wanted to promote it to millennials, and second, older audiences preferred an old-fashioned plot with a digitally appealing appearance.

Overall, I had a great time making this film, from working with the cast and crew to collaborating with the editor and photographer. I hope the audience enjoys this short as much as I did while making it.
