

PABLO C. VERGARA

Pablo C. Vergara was born in Mexico City. At the age of 12, he relocated to Monterrey, Nuevo Leon, where he studied and graduated from the ITESM Tech Institute with a Bachelor's Degree in Communication Science in 2009. In 2016, he won a partial Talent Scholarship at the prestigious New York Film Academy, where he studied a Masters in Fine Arts in Filmmaking at the New York Campus, and received a certificate for his first year in September 2017. He was awarded another scholarship for Talent for his second year, which is still pending to complete.

For over 20 years, he has compiled a vast body of work including, but not limited to, producing, screenwriting, directing, cinematography and editing, on feature films, short films, music videos, commercial videos and documentaries. He is also an actor with various credits for short films, music videos and documentaries. He has various credits and awards in photography. He is also a web designer, a published author, a professional musician and music scorer.

He is best known for his film, 'Necromurder: A Black Metal Story,' which he wrote, directed, produced, starred in and composed the music for. The main narrative of the story is inspired by the real murder of Oysten Arseth Aka. Euronymous, from the metal band, Mayhem, and the film is also partly biographical. The 30 minute film won the award for Best International Fictional Film at FICIME Festival first edition in 2019, and later, won the award for Best Music at the Shockfest International Film Festival in Winter 2020. The film has been expanded into a Feature Film and is in current post production stages. The cast features the award winning South African actor Jonathan Pienaar (Blood Diamond, Empire of the Sharks, Troy: Fall of A City), and it also features the horror expert and President of Shockfest, Jeffery Macabre, and the premier of the tattoo legend, Paul Booth, in an acting role.

The final draft screenplay for sequel for the film has been completed and has a few Hollywood celebrities attached to it, including LOIs.

Some other bodies of work of his are the screenplays, 'The Darkest of Fears,' a vampire story that took him ten years to write and made the finalist at the worldwide Page Awards Screenplay Competition 2015, in the category of horror. The script, 'Behind the Sun,' a serial killer thriller inspired by an FBI unsolved crime that dates back to the late 60s, and 'The Heart of Doom,' a sci-fi/thriller of a cursed heart that gets transplanted to multiple people and destroys their lives.

He is an avid composer and musician with an over 25 year career span in music, a seasoned guitar player, singer and keyboardist with many musical projects, where the most well known is Dynasty of Darkness, that includes several guest metal legend musicians with Grammy Awards and Golden Record wins. His debut album, 'Empire of Pain,' shares credits as co-producer along with the metal icon, Steve Tucker, of the world famous band, Morbid Angel.

President of The List Productions (2006 - Present). Works as an executive producer at Global Watch Productions, UK. President of the RAMIFF Rock and Metal International Film Festival.

In 2013 Pablo Vergara stayed at the Cecil Hotel in Downtown LA an incident that would later create a lot of controversy in his artistic career; He was blamed by the entire internet world to be the suspected killer of Elisa Lam the Canadian girl who stayed and died and was found in the Hotel's water tank in 2014 causing extreme cyberbullying , death threats and the Cancelling of his brand. This incident ultimately derailed his very successful music career.

Last year NETFLIX contacted him with an invitation to help produce and participate the number one Crime Scene Series directed by the Emmy Awards Winner and Academy Awards Nominee Joe Berlinger, where they dispel all the rumours and false accusations that were blamed upon him, his participation on this show granted him the opportunity to talk to the world about #mentalhealth #stopcyberbullying and landed him on the cover of Goth Macabre Magazine with the title "Cyberbullying's Worst Nightmare".

During the remaining of the year he gave interviews and his story was massively publicised on many of the world's most relevant media sources such as Variety, Cosmopolitan; Playboy; Primer Impacto, Men's Health, Women's Health, Entertainment Tonight, Daily Express, The Sun, etc....

Last month he participated in The CW Network Show Mysteries Decoded with Jennifer Marshall from Stranger Things where they took him back to the Cecil Hotel.

Another highlight was when Jared Leto call his phone expressing his support and wishing to collaborate on future projects together and our proposal to invite him to our Franchise is pending.
