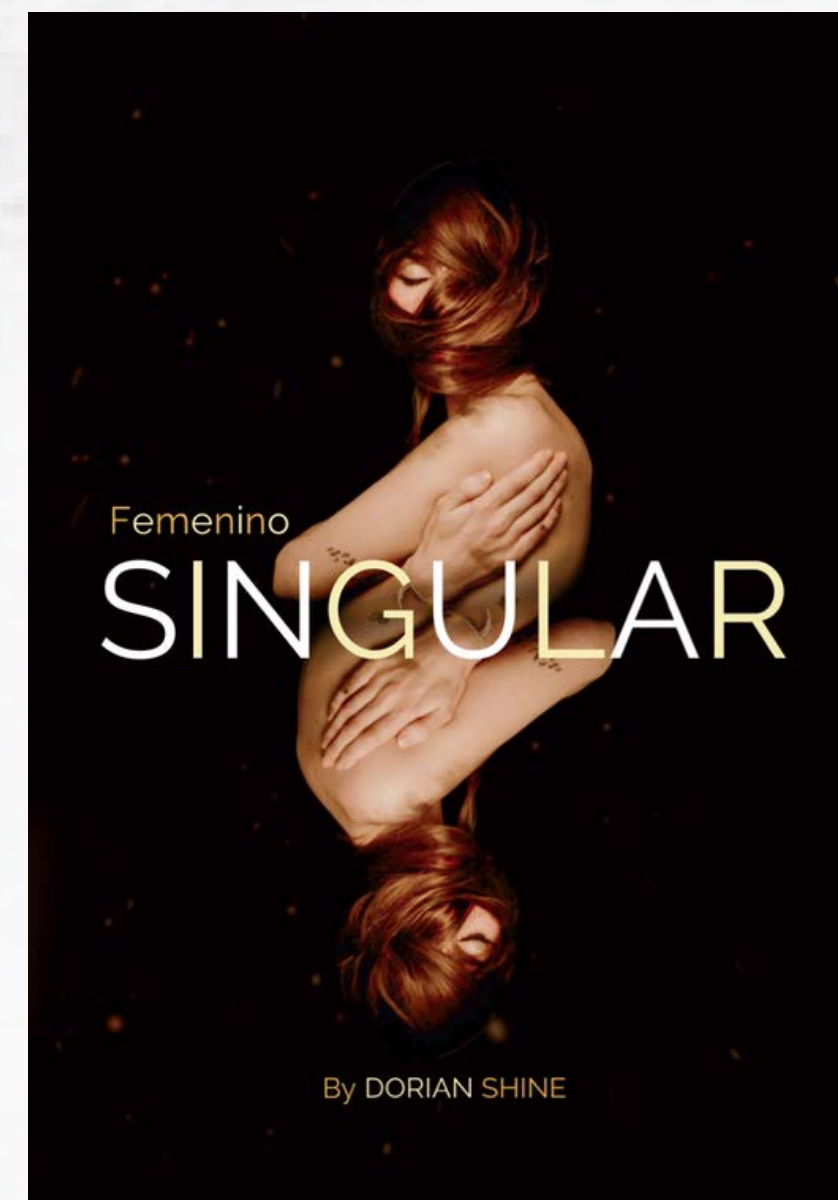


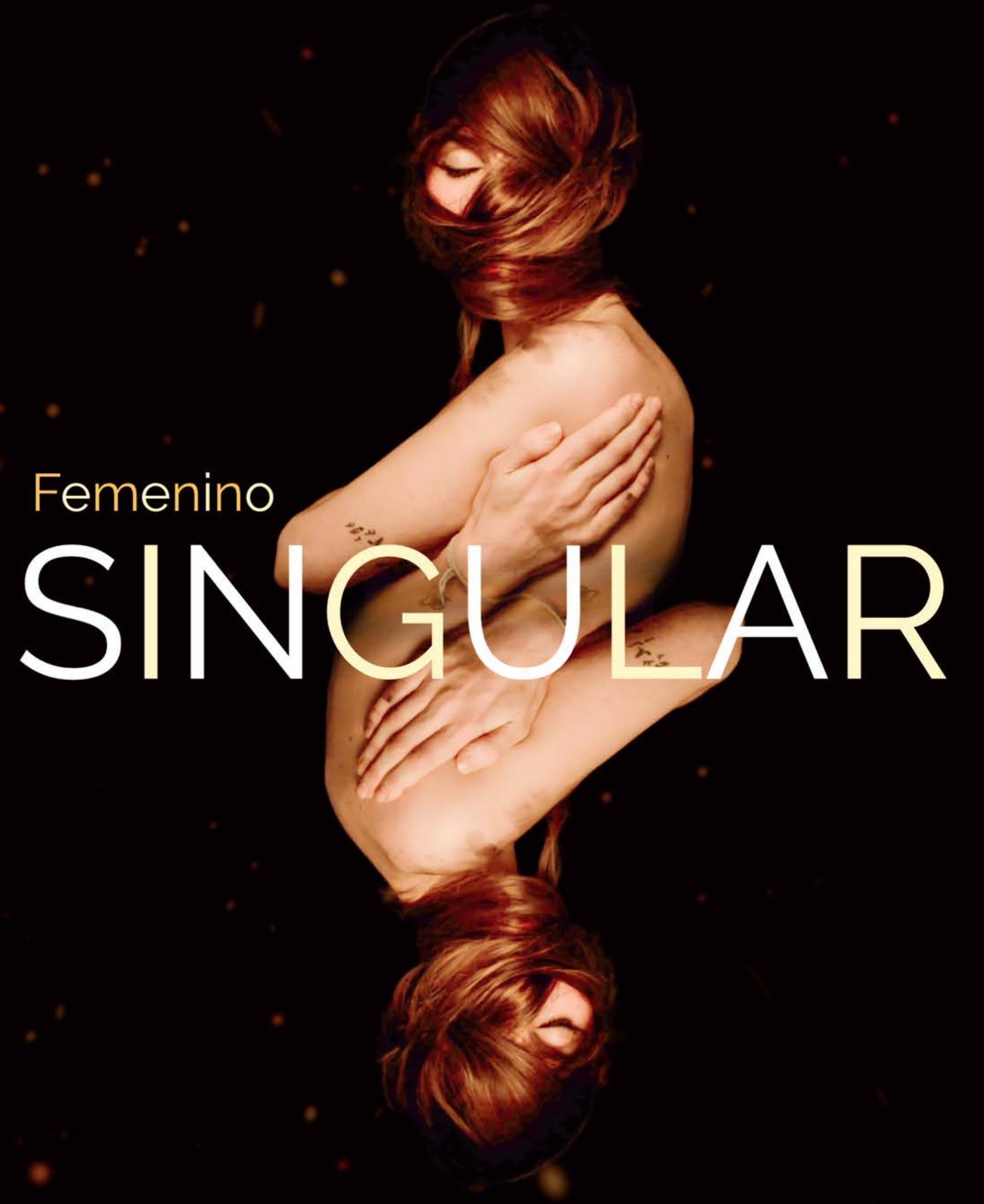

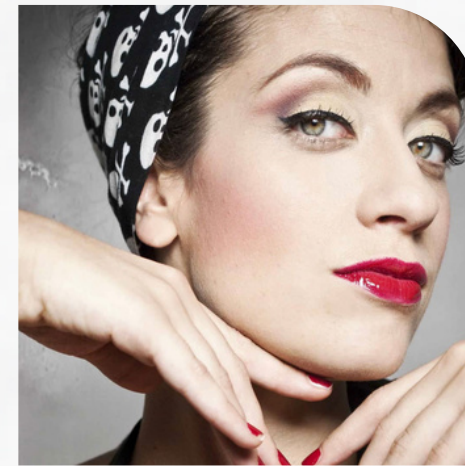
- Romina J. Alves : Nurtured by stories and poetry

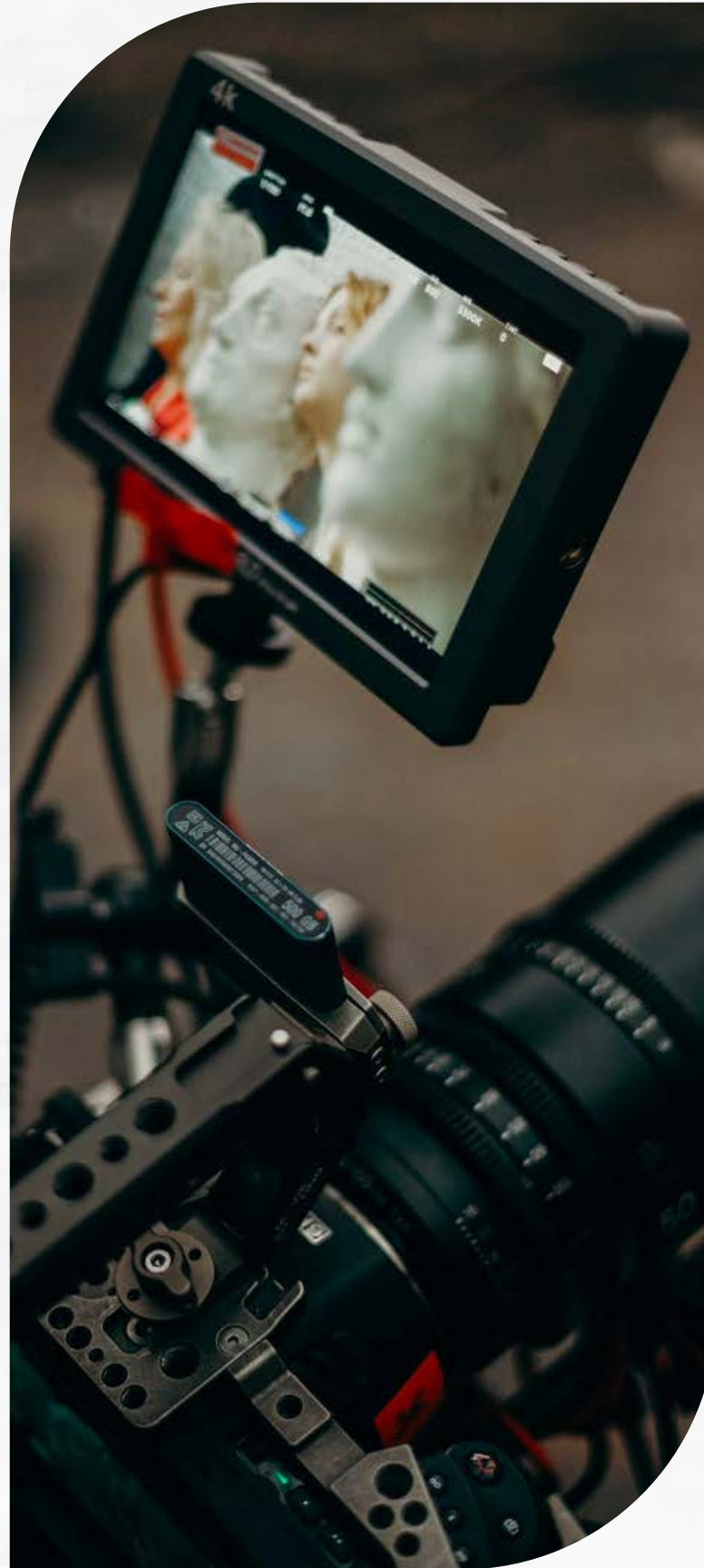

EXCERPTS FROM "FEMININE SINGULAR"

"My identity as a person is not confined to my face. There is a "me" in every part of my body, in my flesh, in my sexuality, in my history, in my experiences, and in my soul"

"When I think about my mother now, I realize she didn't choose to be the way she was. She was shaped by societal norms that she wasn't entirely happy with. She lived in a time and place where being different wasn't easy. The model was imposed on her, and she felt depressed. For me, that model wasn't something I admired or wanted to follow. Instead, I aimed to move in the opposite direction."

"Now, I see myself happy, liberated from the submission's closet. Freed of the victim role I once identified with and submitted to for many years."

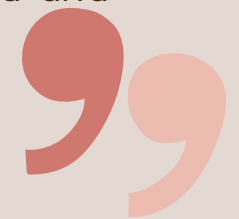
In my workplace, predominantly occupied by men, I must present myself as tough, cold, distant, devoid of any emotional display. I am unable to be emotionally expressive and must remain composed throughout the day. This often leaves me feeling disconnected from my true self, and at times, I lose myself in the process.

*"To know **the woman**, one must know the story of each woman that this earth has borne and will bear."*

"It's about knowing that you can be, you are, and you feel like a woman. It goes beyond menstruation and beyond having a child. The feeling of being a woman."

I'm 49 years old, and I tell you no to hair dye! I say: No! to anti-aging creams. I say No! to Botox. I'm not willing to get Botox. I'm not going to outline my lips because they wrinkle. I'm not going to lift my cheekbones or get any facial prosthesis. Definitely, I tell you No!

"I feel more free when I'm traveling. When I don't have a home where I'd accumulate belongings. When I carry my home on my back. Because everything I have is in my backpack, and I don't need anything else. Moving around, this is my freedom. Choosing where to sleep every night. With whom. How. This is, for me, complete freedom. Some time ago, thanks to using my freedom, I found myself, my center, my being. Not what was shaped and learned from childhood in a specific context and society."

Infusing the documentary with transition videos filmed in Toronto, along with a small Canadian crew unit, during the pandemic, added a touch of resilience and innovation to the film's creation.

The goal was to highlight a wide spectrum of life experiences and perspectives showcasing the multifaceted nature of female identity and to include narratives that resonate with themes of strength, resilience, and self-discovery. Each woman's story became a vibrant thread, skillfully woven together to create a powerful narrative that honours their unique identities.

How does the filmmaker's personal journey as a nomad or immigrant and being part of the LGBTQ+ community influence the movie?

The documentary "Feminine Singular" weaves a compelling narrative that is enriched by the filmmaker's personal journey as an immigrant in Argentina and Canada. This experience provides a fresh and unfiltered lens through which the captivating stories of Argentinian women are portrayed, allowing for a unique and unbiased perspective. Although the documentary doesn't directly focus on LGBTQ+ topics, the inclusion of the filmmaker's queer and non-binary identity and the involvement of key LGBTQ+ members in the cast and crew speak to the film's commitment to diversity and inclusivity. By embracing various identities and experiences, the film challenges the notion that queer identity is solely related to sexual orientation, expanding the audience's understanding of what it means to be LGBTQ+.

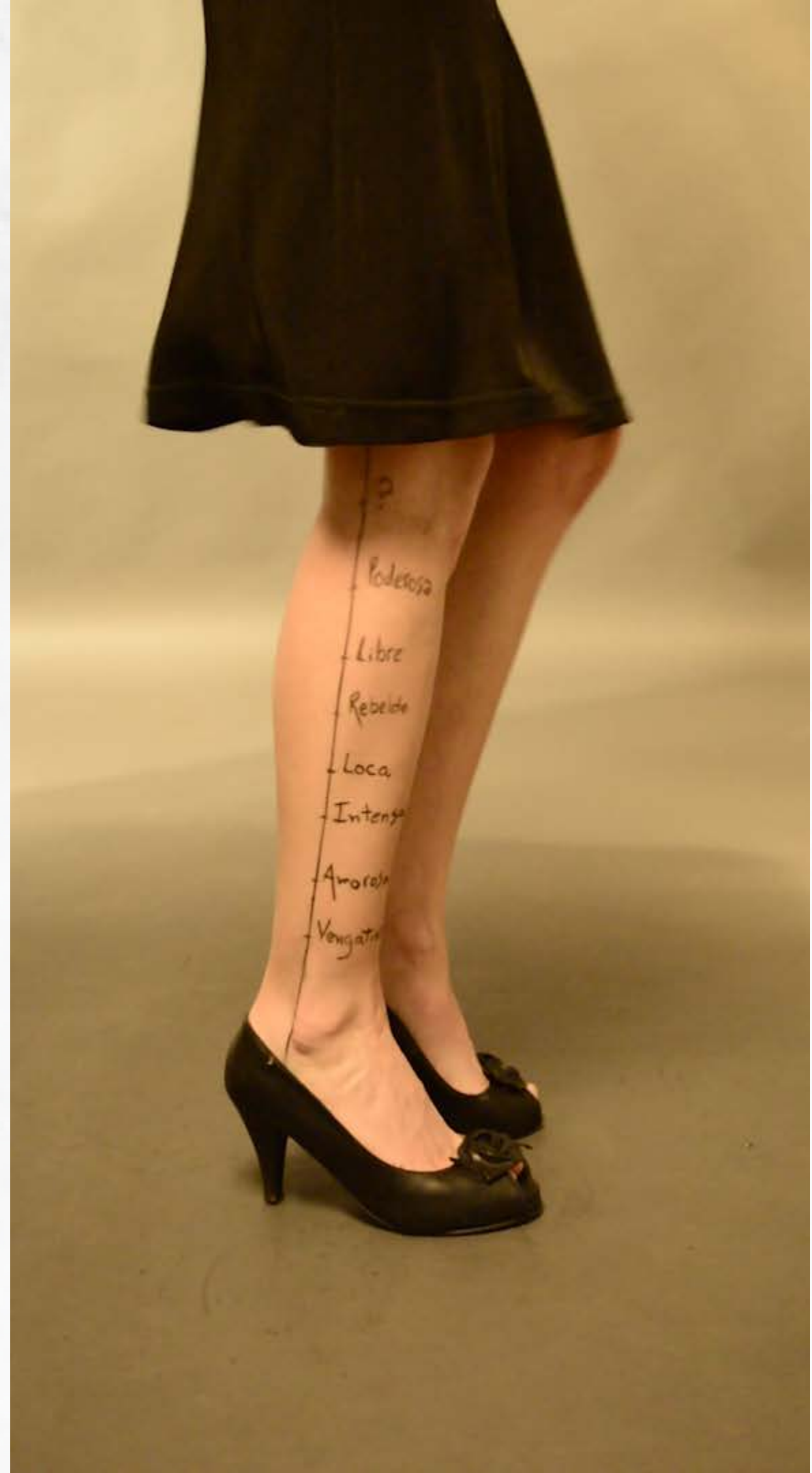
