ADAM GIERASCH

Director

Adam Gierasch has loved the horror genre all his life, and has been creating horror movies (as an actor, writer and now director) for twenty years. Adam and his writing partner Jace Anderson were mentored early in their careers by legendary horror director Tobe Hooper (*Texas Chainsaw Massacre*, *Poltergeist*.) Gierasch co-wrote three scripts for Hooper, including cult favorite *The Toolbox Murders*. He co-wrote a script for acclaimed horror director/novelist Clive Barker, and collaborated with Italy's most famous horror director, Dario Argento, on *The Mother of Tears*. *The Mother of Tears* is the long-awaited sequel to Argento's films *Suspiria* and *Inferno*.

Gierasch's directorial debut, *Autopsy*, starred Robert Patrick (*Terminator 2*, *The Unit*) as a crazed doctor willing to go to any length to save his dying wife. The film premiered at London's Frightfest 2008 to an enthusiastic audience. He followed that up with *Night of the Demons*, a remake of the 1980s classic, and *Fertile Ground*, a haunted house tale starring Gale Harold and Leisha Hailey. His last feature was *Fractured*, a neo-noir/horror mystery starring Callum Blue and Vinnie Jones. Adam also has a segment in the 2015 anthology film *Tales of Halloween*. He follows this history up with 2023's *Spaghetti*.

LYLE HOWRY

Producer

Lyle Howry is an award-winning film producer, member of the Producers Guild Of America (p.g.a.) actor and philanthropist with over thirty five years and over in the entertainment industry, and over 200 productions. He has co-produced the two-time Emmy winning TV series "*The Dukes of Hazzard*" along with Jon Voight's family drama "*A Dog of Flanders*" which won a Bronze Gryphon Award and was nominated for a Joseph Plateau Award.

In 1999 Howry launched Skinfly Entertainment which released the internationally successful MMA action combat film "*Street*" that was on Netflix worldwide and continues to stream on several other major platforms. 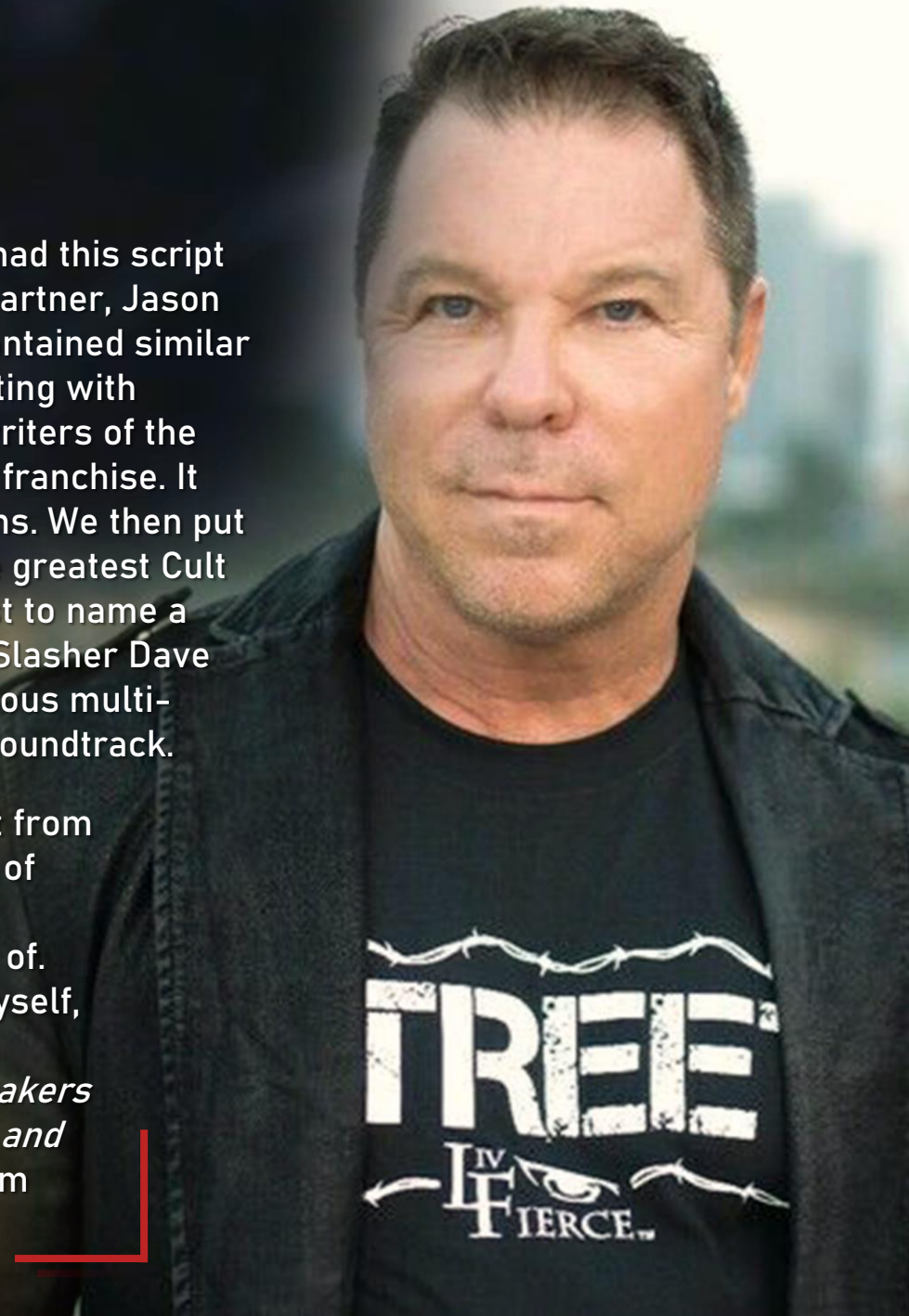

PRODUCER STATEMENT

We received a call from a digital streaming company. I once helped to build. They had this script titled, *Spaghetti*. It was based on Voodoo and caught my attention, along with my partner, Jason Rainwater. We were in development on our own film project titled, *Voodoo*, that contained similar elements. So instead of moving forward with our in-house project, we took a meeting with Markice Moore, who not only acts in the film, but was the creator and one of the writers of the script, along with Jason Rainwater. I loved the film. It reminded me of the *Scream* franchise. It has some slapstick comedy lines, but is also very scary, with many twists and turns. We then put together a great team, starting with Adam Gierasch, who has directed some of the greatest Cult Horror films out there, *Tales of Halloween*, *Fractured* and *Night of the Demons* just to name a few. Adam has been instrumental to this film, giving it a special touch, as well as Slasher Dave with his special beats and my longtime friend, Francesco Benincaso, from the famous multi-Grammy winning recording studio, *1500 or Nothin*, giving us an all-original fresh soundtrack.

This film was all about teamwork and everyone gave it 100%. We simply lucked out from our editor, Andrew Kasch, *Gotham Knights*, *DC'S Legends of Tomorrow* and editor of many other hit films and television shows. Our DP, Andrew Parke, *Independence Day*, *Godzilla* and *Night Of The Living Dead* to name a few films he has been a part of. We really had a lot of seasoned film makers and great acting. Adam, Jason and myself, also loved the idea of a predominantly African-American cast, including Newton Mayenge from the new award winning HBO series, *Winning Time: The rise of the Lakers Dynasty*, Brittany Lucio, from *A House Divided* and Markice Moore from *BMF*, *Law and Order*, and *Organized Crime*. All in all, in my 35 years in the movie industry, this film was one of my favorites to produce.
