

“Ninfa” Short Film Sustainability Report

In terms of practical actions during the production phase of the NINFA film we will follow a protocol to be chosen from Green Film or Zen2030, enhancing the easy points project and scaling down the critical ones:

- accommodation for the crew within a maximum 3 km radius of the one or the two locations;
- a daily choice of vegetarian meal;
- booking train travel for all trips under 8 hours;
- use of LED lighting system and exclusively rechargeable batteries;
- provision of an extraordinary electrical connection, avoiding the rental of external generators;
- use of reusable stage or costume materials certified by specific ISOs.

In terms of practical actions being developed, we have decided to mainly follow EAVE's Green Policy made public in 2021, with great attention to daily practices in the office and for the distribution. Just by way of example we list some priorities:

- avoid plastic cups and bottles and other single-use products;
- support the choice to produce workshop and market information materials with digital versions;
- consume a maximum of two meat meals per week;
- we purchase all new equipment and office supplies needed from local stores rather than online retailers whenever possible;
- we avoid all unnecessary printing;
- we further improve office recycling practices by organizing them in a way that compels both the team and visitors to pay attention to recycling;
- when we leave the office, we make sure that all lights are turned off and that, in cold months, heaters are on the lowest heat setting or off during nights and weekends;
- we avoid large attachments whenever possible.
- we use file transfer platforms instead of e-mail attachments;
- we regularly delete old e-mails, especially those with large attachments, and avoid creating long threads.
