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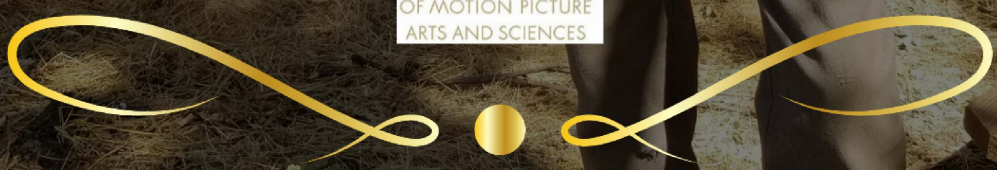

The captain stops and raises his right hand. The head of a gray hair black man comes after his hand out of smog.

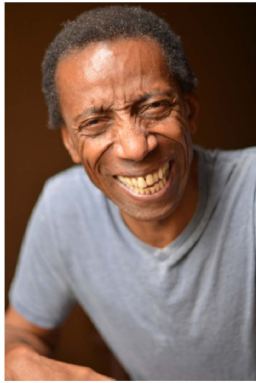

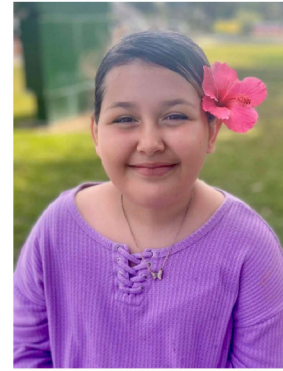

Four awards for an Iranian short script

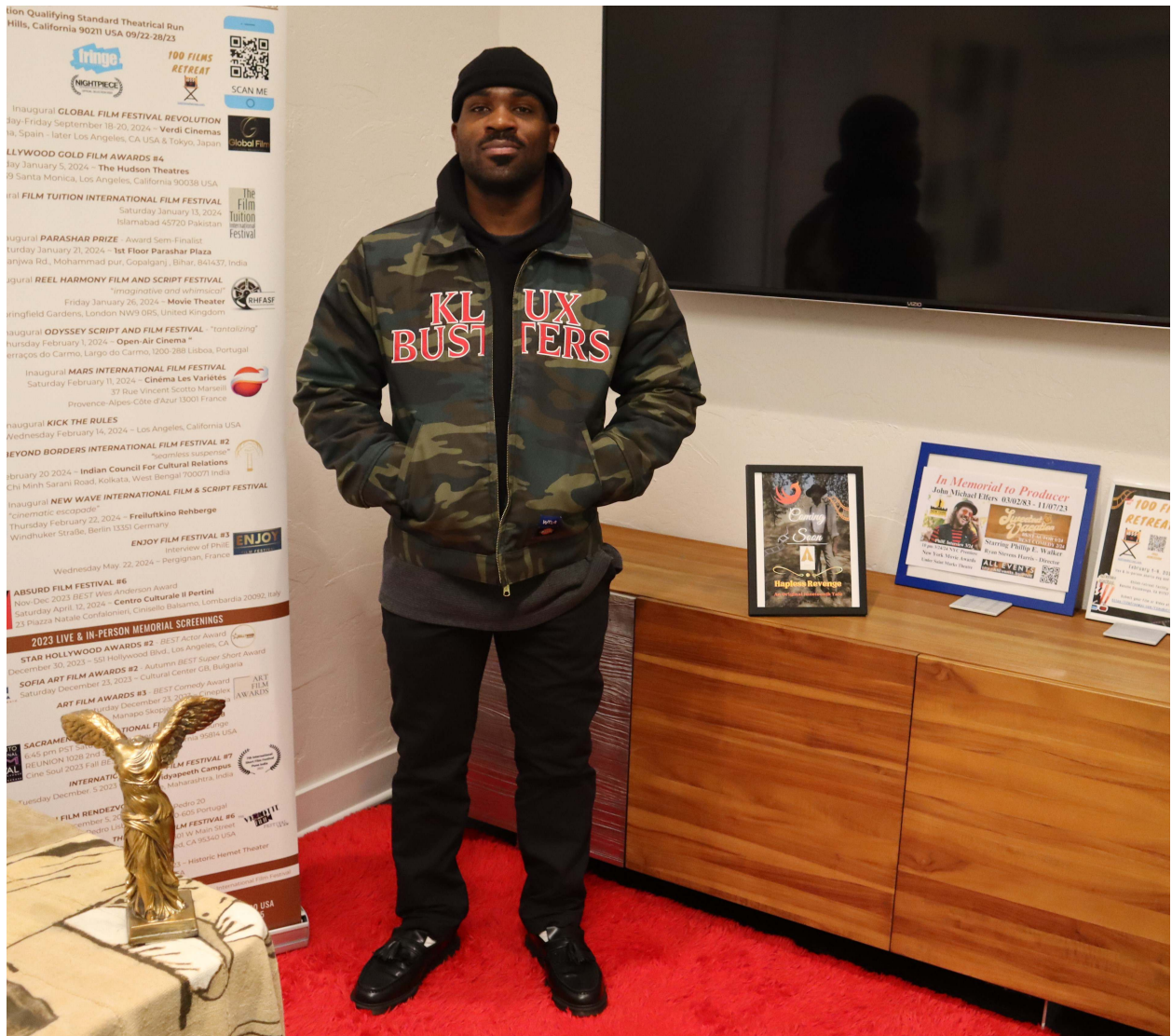
