Logline

Synopsis

Spiritual authorities and Wisdom Keepers from Latin America and Africa journey to the Indian Himalayas to engage with Tibetan elders. They carry the wisdom of their ancestors, including messages such as the prophecy of the Eagle and the Condor, seeking to exchange and learn from Tibetan wisdom and prophecies, particularly those concerning Shambhala. Through seminars and ceremonies, they explore ways of living that could guide humanity out of its current precarious state and toward a brighter, more unified future for all life forms.

These spiritual leaders embody diverse ancient wisdom traditions, and it is in their collective wisdom and complementarity that the strength of this reconnection lies. Following certain prophecies, they endeavor to energetically reconnect all realms and take practical steps to manifest their visions, aiming to initiate a ripple effect toward the creation of a more compassionate, sustainable, and united world for all. This initiative offers an alternative to conventional diplomacy among modern states. It represents a step toward reuniting First Nations, peoples, and ways of life that predate modernity, holding profound knowledge about the world and its direction.

Why/Where

- This documentary film aims to illustrate the convergence of diverse wisdom traditions, ranging from First Nations to Tibetan Buddhists. Spiritual individuals across cultures believe that it is time to unite, share knowledge and values, and protect our environment. They recognize that First Nations possess profound wisdom essential for navigating a world in transition.
- The film serves as a tribute to change and growth, inviting viewers to embrace a global effort for preservation and regeneration, as well as a quest for deeper meaning and understanding of our place in the universe. It emphasizes that indigenous wisdom is accessible to all.
- Filmed in Dharamsala, Indian Himalayas, the documentary captures the refuge area of the Tibetan people following their exodus from China and the residence of His Holiness the Dalai Lama.

The Grand Council of the Eagle and Condor

Since the 1990s, representatives of different Original Nations of the Americas have been coming together to unite their traditions. .
The creation of the 'Grand Council of the Eagle and Condor' represents an expression of this unification process.

A meeting in Sierra Nevada resulted in the creation of Five Earth Mandates. These Mandates will help to direct their work to accomplish their task and to solidify the Unification process. The Mandates that were defined in Sierra Nevada are the following:

- The Creation of the Grand Council of Indigenous Spiritual Elders.
- Protection and reactivation of Sacred Sites.
- To build Houses of Original Wisdom.
- To promote Intercultural Dialogue and Exchange.
- Strengthen Biocultural Territories.

Working closely with organizations such as NiceFuture and the Alliance of the Guardians of Mother Earth, the Grand Council aims to accomplish the mandates and restore balance on Earth as well as manifest the prophecy of the Eagle and the Condor.
