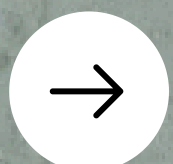

He has been cast in many major productions including "Hunger Games Catching Fire", "Fast and Furious 5", BETs "The Game", "Devious Maids", and BETs "Being Mary Jane". More recently, he starred as Tommy Debarge in TVOne's "The Debarge Story". He filmed his 2nd season of "Monogamy" as Sawyer and promoting his hit show on BET+, "Ruthless" by Tyler Perry as Andrew.



# Candice Vernon

Candice Vernon's directing career took off with her award-winning short film, MAKE AMERICA GREAT?, which she wrote, directed, and produced. The film garnered international attention, screening at festivals worldwide and receiving accolades from The Hollywood Reporter and Decider.com. This success led to her being signed by The Russo Brothers' production company, formerly known as Bullitt. Her career reached new heights when Stevie Wonder personally selected her to direct THE DREAM STILL LIVES, a tribute to Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., featuring collaborations with luminaries such as The Obamas, Common, Paul McCartney, Bruce Springsteen, and Meryl Streep. The video amassed over a billion impressions, propelling Candice into the spotlight and setting her on a trajectory that included becoming a member of the DGA.

Before her rise as a director, Candice was an Executive Producer and Head of Production at an ad agency, where she honed her skills working with brands, production companies, and high-profile directors. Born in Jamaica and raised in the USA and Germany, Candice developed a unique perspective on human experiences, fueling her passion for storytelling. Known for her work in comedy and documentary content, she has directed projects featuring Academy Award-winner Regina King, improv queen Jenny Slate, Sterling K. Brown, and Simu Liu, with clients including NBA2K, Svedka Vodka, Warner Media|HBO, P&G: Cascade, Vaseline, Spotify, Hulu, and BuzzFeed. Candice earned her BA in Film & TV from Temple University and splits her time between Los Angeles and Accra, Ghana.

# Frank Adkinson

*Frank serves as the Writer and Lead Actor, Frank Foxx, in 117 Years of Movie Bullshit.*

Frank Adkinson's true power lies in sharing his perspective on life. He was born and raised in Newport News, Virginia and had big dreams of making it as a content creator. After moving to Atlanta in 2012, Frank started creating content on the once-popular video app known as Vine. He quickly developed a reputation for making comedic content about everyday life occurrences. After several successful attempts at going viral and amassing millions of views, Frank transitioned from social media to Hollywood. In 2015, he relocated to Los Angeles to pursue a career in acting full-time and landed a role with media company All Def Digital. During Frank's tenure at All Def, he worked alongside other rising stars in the entertainment industry. There, he created a parody of Floyd Mayweather's megafight with Manny Pacquiao, titled "Mayweather's Excuse Not To Fight," which gained traction online. Frank went on to land a new role with Laff Mobb's Laff Tracks in 2017. However, the film and TV industry started to slow down and there were fewer opportunities than before. As a result, Frank took a two-year hiatus from acting to focus on his family back on the East Coast. With a renewed sense of passion and vigor, he returned to the big screen in 2019 and was cast in the CW sports drama 'All American' and HBO's 'Insecure.' The subsequent years of his life, spent between securing other acting gigs and filming for the biopic 'Aftershock' (2023), set the stage for Frank's latest venture: launching his production company, Viral Productions – co-founded by actor, model, and former pro-athlete Blue Kimble. Now, in a leadership position, Frank aspires to change the industry from the inside and explore new avenues with unconventional approaches to storytelling. And the journey starts with engineering his own success through the release of the independent film '117 Years of Movie Bullsh\*t' – the first project under his newly formed production company.

# Karen Obilom

Karen Obilom is an American actress most recognized for her standout performances in both film and television. 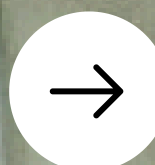


# Jesse C. Boyd
