

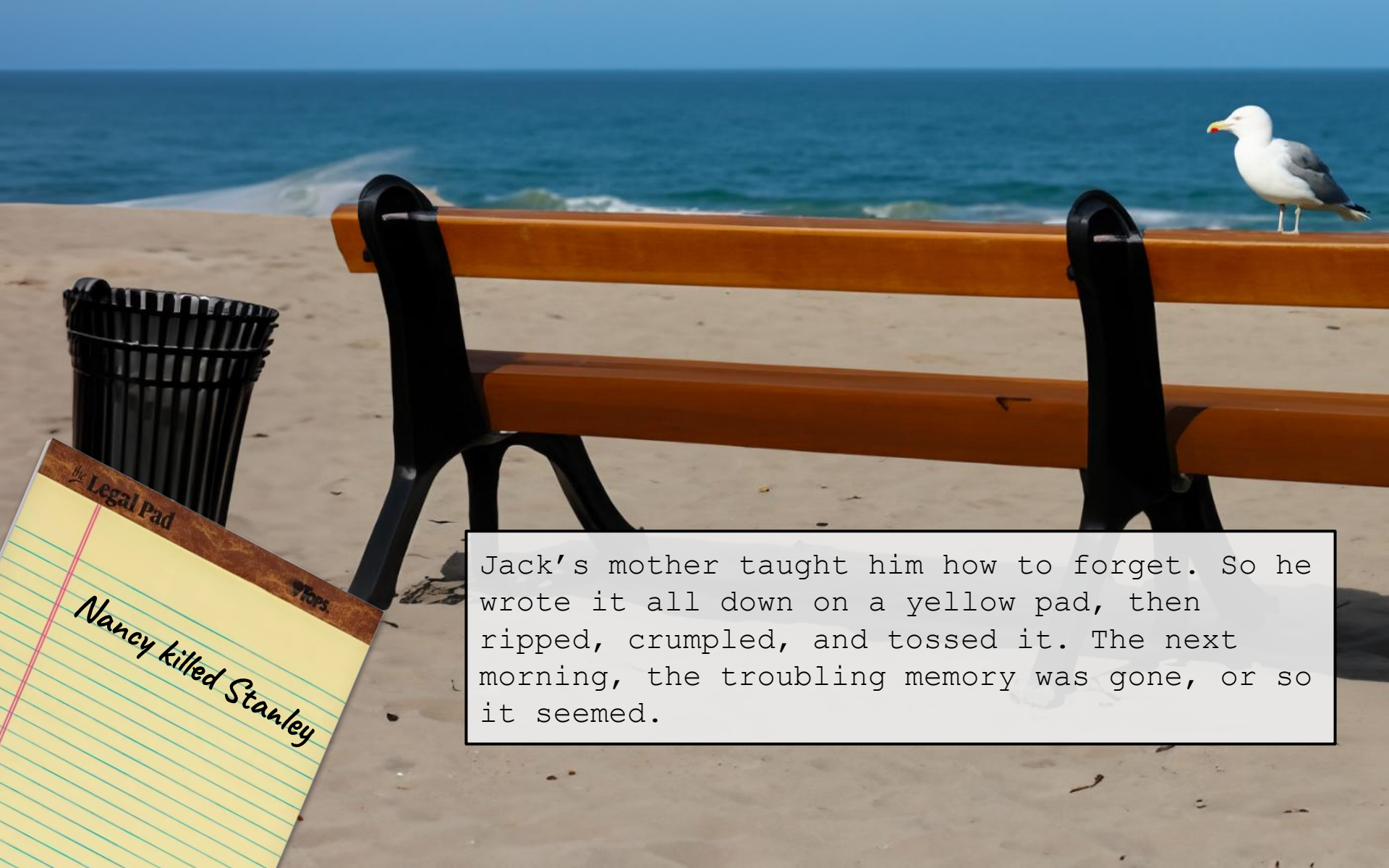
A thriller, romance, and psychological drama.

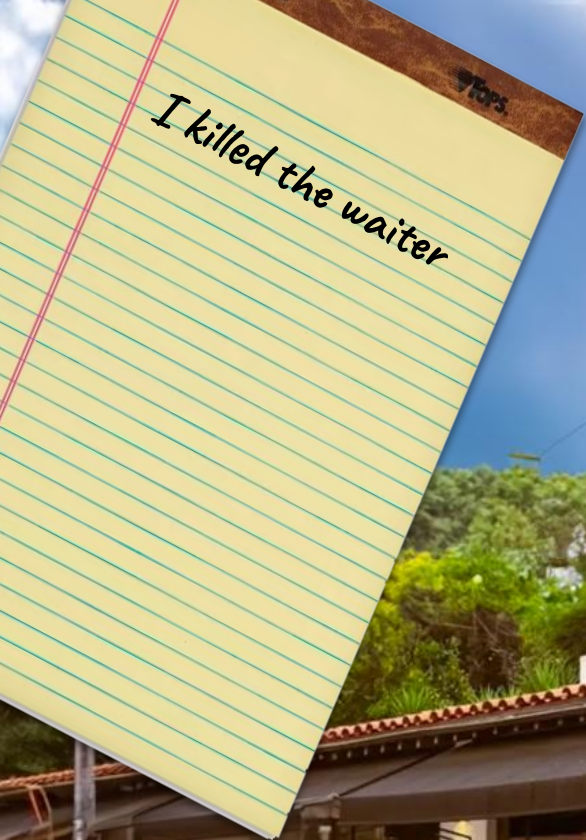
Jack defended his home against intruders, and that lead to a series of deadly encounters.

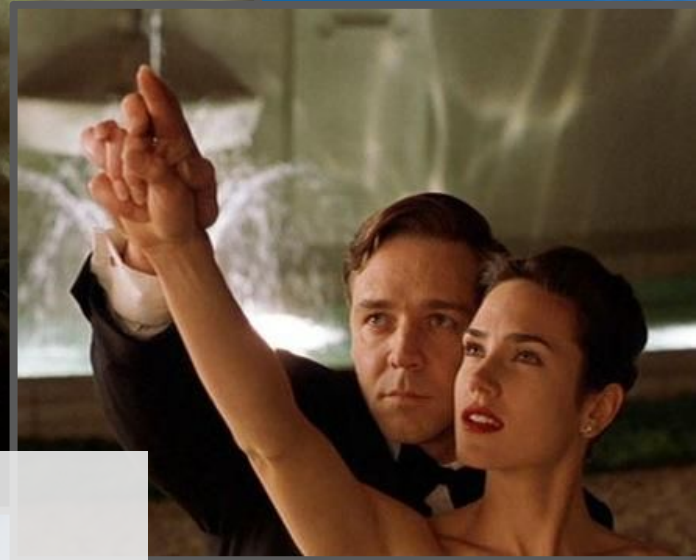

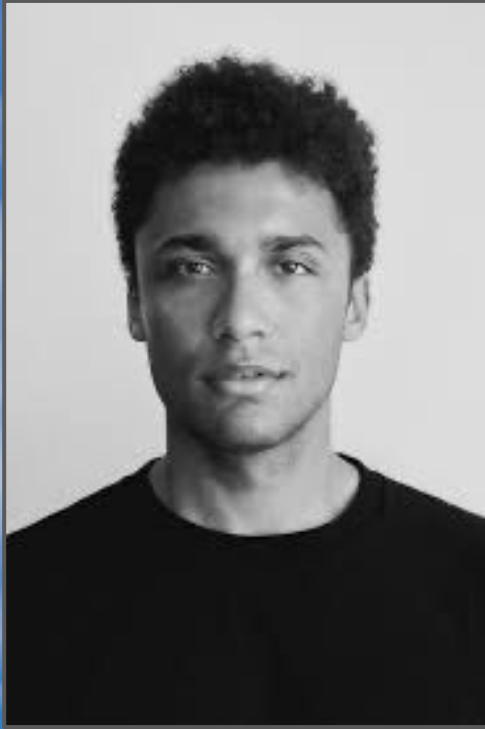

Olivia understood before pulling the trigger not once, but twice, that the two would be pursued for the rest of their lives. Only love could save them.





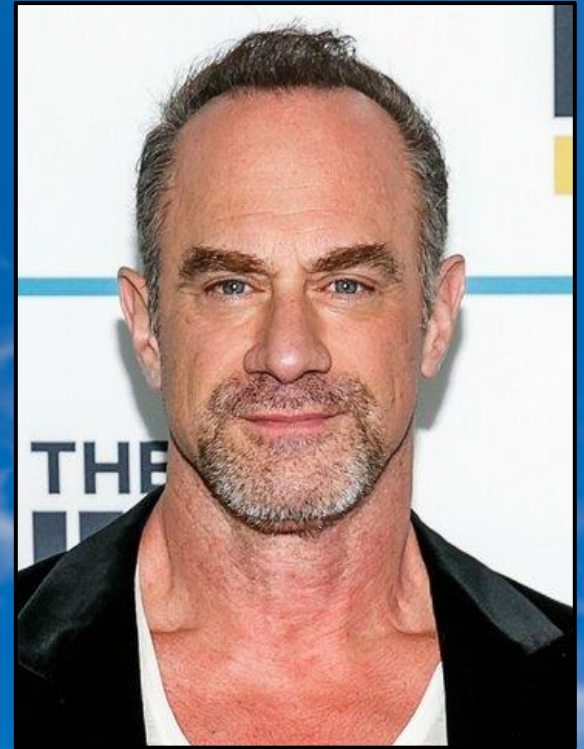

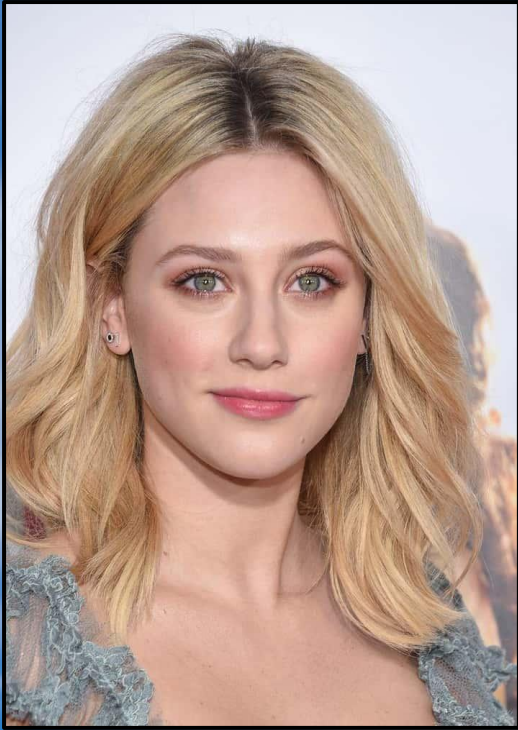
JACK is a community college English professor. He's just a little forgetful sometimes.



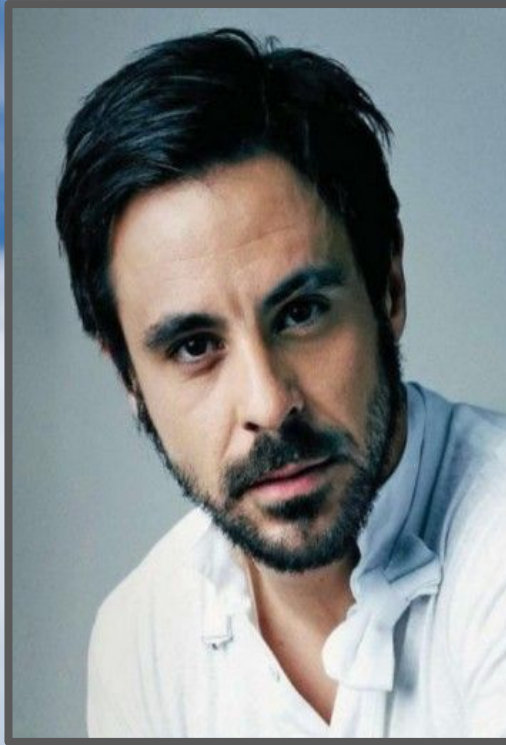
OLIVIA is an artist who uses coffee cups as her canvases. She is very careful about trusting strangers.
