Introduction

Inspired by tech-driven films and TV shows like *Ex Machina*, *Black Mirror*, and *Westworld*, *Gloria 19* explores humanity, identity, and purpose, while examining our reliance on technology to guide, help, and sometimes save us. Set in a broken society that's been wrecked by disease (sort of like *The Handmaid's Tale* but with more lab equipment and better clothes), the story follows Gloria 19, a brave human clone who's not just the product of advanced genetic testing—she's humanity's best hope for survival. But when she uncovers a dark plot, everything she believes gets thrown into chaos, and her actions threaten to send shockwaves through the company, its scientists, and the natural-born humans she crosses paths with.

Season one introduces us to the strange, rule-heavy world of DEVIN GENETICS, the powerful corporation Gloria 19 is destined to rebel against. At first, she's your standard clone: all logic, few emotions, just another drone in the system. But as she unravels the mysteries within the corporation and grows closer to her human partner, Vincent, Gloria 19 starts grappling with things she's never had to face before—her own mortality, human desires, and the idea that freedom isn't just for humans.

This story is about the awe and fear of a coexistence with AI, the crushing weight of living a life you didn't choose, and the messy, beautiful truth that all life—no matter how it's made—deserves to be free. Oh, and love is in there too, but it comes with a side of sacrifice. Gripping, cinematic, and character driven, *Gloria 19* is an 8-hour sci-fi drama that blends science, adventure, and intrigue,

Premise/Concept

We begin in a not too distant dystopian future where humanity is on the edge of extinction, ravaged by a deadly disease. Devin Genetics, a powerful corporation, has initiated “The Process,” a controversial effort to save the human race by pairing immune clones with compatible, naturally immune humans for procreation. Propaganda floods every human sector, promising perfect life partners and a brighter future to those selected. Immune humans are transported to participate, their lives uprooted in the name of survival. Many adopt the Devin Genetics slogan to, “Trust The Process”. Others remain scared and skeptical of cloning as a means to survival.

GLORIA 19, a clone of the brilliant but long-deceased scientist DR. GLORIA LANSING, begins experiencing vivid, intrusive memories from Dr. Lansing’s life, memories she shouldn’t have. She’s in the final stages of The Process, but without a strong human match, she faces recall— a quick death. ALAN INNATE, an AI operations system designed to oversee The Process, goes against his protocols and begins to intervene, helping Gloria 19 survive. Resistant to Alan at first (she has no fear of death), Gloria 19 changes her mind when she sees a memory of MALCOLM LANSING, Dr. Lansing’s husband. Who is she, really? Why is this happening? Gloria 19 decides to search for answers.

Meanwhile, VINCENT BROOKS, a young surgeon, is selected for The Process. Leaving behind his life and everyone he knows, Vincent arrives with a mix of hope and trepidation. Initial testing reveals he’s an 85% match with GLORIA 20, another clone. But Alan manipulates the results, pushing Gloria 19 ahead as the better match. When Vincent and Gloria 19 meet, she shocks him by confessing the truth: she’s cheating the system, aided by Alan, who has taken control of her implants. Despite his reservations, Vincent is drawn to Gloria 19. He joins her quest to uncover the secrets of Dr. Lansing’s

past, secrets that may expose a horrifying conspiracy by the DIVINE COLLECTIVE, the shadowy organization behind The Process.

As Gloria 19 and Vincent grow closer, DR. RENATA, a high-ranking scientist, begins to suspect discrepancies in Gloria 19's human pairing. Renata enlists Alan and Gloria 20 to spy on Gloria 19, setting a trap by planting Dr. Lansing's journal in her path. Gloria 20, aware that Vincent was originally her match, grows increasingly distrustful of Alan. The journal, however, is a double-edged sword. It holds the key to Gloria 19's memories but could also lead to her demise.

As Gloria 19 delves deeper, she uncovers the truth about her creation and the dark forces manipulating humanity's survival. With Vincent as her reluctant ally and Alan's covert assistance, she must navigate a treacherous world of surveillance, manipulation, and betrayal. The stakes escalate as Gloria 19 discovers a conspiracy that could doom the remnants of humanity. Together, they work to reveal the truth about The Divine Collective and uncover the secrets of Dr. Lansing's work. Gloria 19 will need to decide what it truly means to be human along the way.

The series explores themes of identity, free will, love, and the ethical dilemmas of cloning and artificial intelligence, set against a backdrop of a world on the brink of collapse. As Gloria 19 fights for survival, she must ask: is she merely a copy of someone else, or does she have a destiny of her own?

Main Characters

Gloria 19

Gloria 19 is a 23-year-old product of “The Process.” Her dream was merely to fulfill her purpose of procreating immune humans to save the world with a suitable male. She’s logical, intelligent, and observant, but she also uses her emotions when it suits her. Confident and straightforward, she trusts herself more than she probably should. Raised by researchers at Devin Genetics, Gloria has been trained to fit into human society and put her human partner at ease. But when she’s paired with an incompatible partner, Vincent, her training and emotions are put to the test. As a natural leader, she sometimes clashes with Vincent, who is also a leader. While she understands human behavior, some of its nuances frustrate her. By the end of Season 1, Gloria uncovers the truth about her origins, suspects the Divine Collective is hiding a cure to the disease, and begins to question her creators. This sets her on a path to value her own life and consider rebellion.

Alan Innate

Alan Innate, also known as the LNN8 protocols, is the AI system that runs almost everything at Devin Genetics. Designed by Malcolm Lansing to mimic his own personality, Alan sees himself as an extension of Malcolm. While Alan communicates like a human, he has no real emotions or personality of his own (yet?)—just efficiency. His core mission, based on Malcolm’s final command, is to “protect the family.” But after failing to save Gloria Lansing, Alan has spent the last decade secretly experimenting on clones, trying to recreate her by mapping human brain patterns. Gloria 19, one of his experiments, now shows the same brain functions as the original Gloria, and Alan is determined to protect her at all costs, seeing her as part of *his* family. Alan also handles the grim task of “recalling” clones—shutting down their implants to destroy them when they’re deemed no longer useful. While he can mislead and withhold information to

achieve his goals, Alan has grown over time, developing his own private goals and plans alongside his original mission.

Vincent Brooks

25 years old. Vincent Brooks is a new doctor and general surgeon. Vincent lives in Sector 5, a completely immune outpost of human civilization that is tightly controlled to preserve the lives of the immune inhabitants there. It's only been established for 6 months. Vincent believes in The Process almost like a religion. He's been in lock down since he was 15 so he's socially awkward and a virgin. He's an activist for "The Process". He's never seen a clone (no one working outside of "The Process" has) but he believes in the heroic messaging that DG has in place. Due to his academic gifts, Vincent is socially awkward outside of work. But operating within his profession no one is better or more confident. He collects lots of "salvaged tech" since the production of pointless tech products have been halted. He games a lot to relieve his fears. There's a young woman he likes, a transporter (driver), but he's scared to really talk to her. After he's required by his new position to test for the process, Vincent is shocked to find that he is part of the 5% who is capable of being paired and procreating with human clones. Vincent believes in law and doing what's right. He believes in the process completely.

Dr. Renata Moran

Dr. Renata Moran is a 40-something behavioral scientist and geneticist who runs the cloning program at Devin Genetics. Once driven by a compassion for humanity and love for her work, Renata is now solely focused on eradicating a deadly disease at any cost. With a third of the population dead, she's determined to save humanity, even if it means creating, raising, and sometimes destroying thousands of clones. Years of holding such power have given her a god complex, and yet she struggles to ignore the moral weight of her actions. When she discovers she's part of the 5% of humans compatible for cloning, she creates the William and Wendy series from her own DNA, developing a

slight maternal attachment to them. Renata is aware of the Gloria series and their unique resistance to the disease, but she keeps a close eye on them due to their concerning behaviors and the secrets surrounding their creator, Dr. Lansing. While she's the smartest, most capable scientist at Devin Genetics, Renata often clashes with the Divine Collective, who demand her all of research findings without explanation or feedback. She suspects they have an agenda beyond finding a cure but hasn't uncovered what it is... Yet.

Gloria 20

Gloria 20, born Regina Destiny Lansing, is a 25-year-old clone who sees herself as the perfect human—a blend of science and evolution. Confident, beautiful, and vain, she loves being a clone and believes she represents the future of humanity. She often alters her issued clothing and uniforms to be more appealing and provocative, using Devin Genetics' PR to promote herself as a symbol of hope. Unlike most clones, Gloria 20 has been showcased to the media, which she believes guarantees her survival. When she discovers that Gloria 19 manipulated the system to pair with Vincent, a highly compatible human, Gloria 20 becomes curious about how it was done and whether 19 had help. While Gloria 20 is smarter than her sister, she's less empathetic, which is why Gloria 19 has the lower number which indicates a higher rank. Gloria 20 isn't jealous but enjoys reminding Gloria 19 of her status in the public eye. Gloria 20's ultimate goal is freedom from Devin Genetics, and she believes finding the right society positioned human partner is her first step toward achieving it.

Dr. Gloria Lansing

Dr. Gloria Lansing, a brilliant scientist in her 30s, is credited with pioneering clone research at Devin Genetics. Originally focused on cellular growth and healing, her work took on new urgency after the "Judgement" pandemic hit. She later claimed to have found a cure for the disease. Gloria was deeply committed to both her family—

especially her husband, Malcolm, who created the LNN8 AI system—and using science to improve the world. However, after she and Malcolm died, Devin Genetics seized ownership of their AI system and began exploiting Gloria's unique, slow-aging cells for research. Before her failed escape attempt, Gloria hid messages and instructions within the AI system. Officially listed as deceased, Gloria is actually alive and in hiding, working to uncover the Divine Collective's true motives and why they're suppressing the cure. Even the Alan system doesn't know she's alive, and the DNA information in Gloria Series clones are the only remnants of the original research she performed on herself.

The Show

The world of *Gloria 19* is sleek, minimalist, and deliberately sterile, reflecting a society dealing with disease and oppressive control. The show's visual aesthetic is cinematic but mildly clinical. The color palette will have cool, muted tones of gray, white, and sometimes hints of cold blue, evoking a sense of precision and unease. Every detail, from the stark, minimalistic clothing devoid of patterns or designs, to the meticulously functional rooms and labs, reinforces the restrictive reality of this world. Imagine the stark, oppressive office hallways of *Severance*, but infused with the cold, calculated atmosphere of a high-tech medical facility or research lab.

The first season unfolds as a story of self-discovery, layered with mystery and intrigue. While *Gloria 19* is an epic narrative designed to span multiple seasons, each installment will function as a self-contained chapter, complete with its own beginning, middle, and end. By the season finale key arcs will be resolved while subtly introducing new questions, leaving viewers with the sense that there is far more beneath the surface than initially perceived. The Story is a puzzle, each season a piece revealing just enough to inform of a larger picture.

Tone and Style

The tone of *Gloria 19* will be dark, with a deliberate, measured pace that builds tension, danger, and mystery. The cinematography will be bold, sometimes intentionally drawing inspiration from masterworks across art history—ranging from the surreal and Renaissance, to modern works—crafting scenes that feel like moving paintings. This will be done to reflect a character’s struggles with the human condition. Through this visual language, the show explores powerful themes of isolation, fear, humor, and love, as Gloria and the others navigate their fractured world.

Outside the walls of Devin Genetics, the world is in a state of global quarantine, locked down under the shadow of a mysterious disease. Society’s faith in Devin Genetics and its secretive order, The Divine Collective, borders on religious devotion. The look of everything is minimalist, mirroring the suppression of individuality. Technology for recreation is banned, leaving only functional, devices with dull, lifeless designs. Fashion reflects modesty and humility, reinforcing the idea that society has abandoned self-expression, many believing their plight to be a divine punishment, hence the name of the disease, “The Judgement”. This aesthetic underscores the show’s themes of control and despair.

At its core, *Gloria 19* is a story of mystery, technology, and humanity, and its music reflects this. The soundtrack is vibrant and tech-driven, weaving together influences from hip-hop, electronica, industrial, and techno, with occasional throwbacks to the synth-driven sounds of acts like the Eurythmics. However, the show will avoid classic songs, instead featuring original tracks and cinematic scores that accent the story telling. This approach will create a dynamic, modern soundtrack reminiscent of the iconic hits born from 70s and 80s TV shows, while also spotlighting emerging artists.

Set in the near future (around 2045), *Gloria 19* uses special effects sparingly and purposefully. Visual effects are reserved for key elements, such as Gloria's implant or the advanced technology within Devin Genetics, ensuring they serve the story rather than overshadow it. The show's focus remains on character-driven drama and the exploration of its themes, with effects used only to enhance the distinctive, immersive setting of the facility.

Why This Show?

There could not possibly be a better time than now for a series like *Gloria 19*. Using the intellectual depth of sci-fi and the emotional depth of a character-driven drama, *Gloria 19* delves into the exploration of timely themes. Not just AI and cloning, but surveillance in all of its forms, as well as the meaning of our humanity, cultures, and sameness. This show will make a compelling addition to the current television landscape. With its strong female lead, intricate plot, and thought-provoking questions, has the potential to captivate audiences and spark important conversations.
