The film features the original song 'Figure It Out', written and produced by musical brothers Jimi and Louis Fisher from the band *Boy Bleach*. The song was sung by Fran herself as she wanted to incorporate a unique song to explore the film's themes and act as an easter egg for audiences.



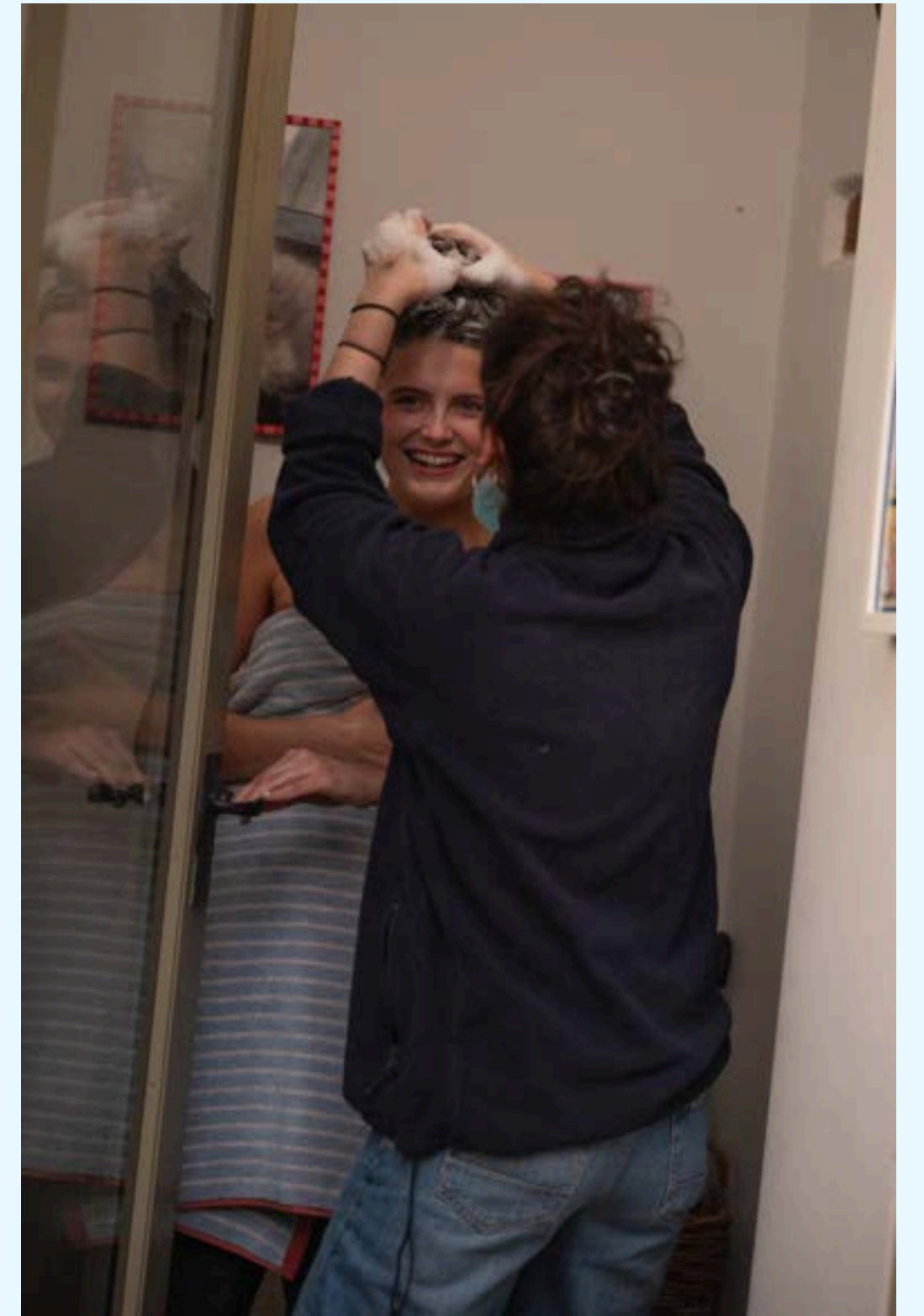
Behind The Scenes
