PILOT SYNOPSIS

A routine investigation into a missing synthetic goes awry. A down and out detective, Val Edwards, discovers a nefarious coverup of a brutal homicide in one of New Africa's "Free Zones."


During the course of his investigation he meets "John," a highly advanced synthetic like nothing he's ever interacted with before. John's apparently false conviction for the murder of a little girl and his seeming self-awareness eventually lead to far-reaching implications for Moloch's society as a whole.
