Logline

Synopsis

Messiah continues the epic arc of The Harmony Saga. Following the chaos of Prophet, Sam, a soulmarked warrior and reluctant heir to the Spiral's divine lineage, journeys into exile after tragedy rips through her fleet and her faith.

Haunted by loss and hunted by zealots, Sam must navigate a shattered galaxy, confronting betrayal, love, and destiny itself. Alongside Max, her tactician and eternal flame, she uncovers ancient truths about the Spiral, the Godhead, and the Dual Christ prophecy—realizing that salvation may not lie in power, but in sacrifice.

Spanning worlds and souls, *Messiah* is both an interstellar drama and a spiritual odyssey—an allegorical mirror of our own divided age.
