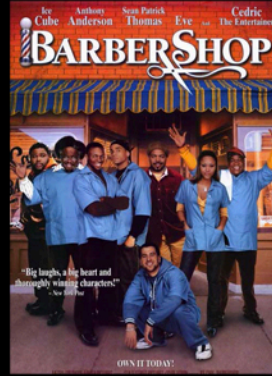

VERONICA – (White, early-30s) Think **JESSICA ROTHE** or **MAIKA MONROE**

PLOT

POPS, the founder of a successful marijuana shop, has finally decided to retire after years of hard work. But before he steps down, he wants to test his son **JACOB**'s ability to take over the family business. Jacob, a young man with little experience in the legal, recreational marijuana industry, is left to run the shop for the day. As he tries to handle the daily operations and deal with a cast of colorful characters, he quickly realizes that running the shop is not as easy as he thought it would be. With unexpected challenges and obstacles thrown his way, Jacob must prove to his father that he has what it takes to continue the family legacy.

SUBPLOTS

ZIP demands that Jacob abandon the dispensary and return to a life of street-level drug dealing, Jacob must decide whether to stick with the business that his father built, or risk everything to return to his old ways and keep Zip happy. As the tension builds, Jacob finds himself caught in the middle of a dangerous power struggle that could have life-altering consequences for everyone involved.

ARLEN and **CHRIS** team up to rob the marijuana shop, but their plan is complicated by the presence of Zip, and the police who are ready to raid the shop, along with Chris's inner turmoil as he grapples with his conflicting beliefs about the American dream and the criminal activity they are engaging in.
