**LOGLINE:**

*A young woman, desperate for change, falls into the clutches of a mysterious infomercial offering a 24-hour solution to her woes, but soon discovers the terrifying truth behind its promises as she confronts an otherworldly transformation.*

## SYNOPSIS:

*Anya, a disillusioned young woman, stumbles upon a surreal late-night infomercial promising a 24-hour solution to unhappiness. Isolated and yearning for validation, she impulsively orders the product after being dismissed by Ryan, a man she hoped would see her differently.*

*When the package arrives, Anya follows its eerie instructions—implanting a strange, egg-like object into her body. As the transformation begins, she finds herself manipulated by an increasingly sentient TV set and a sinister radio broadcast, both pushing her toward an irreversible fate.*

*Behind the glossy screen, the infomercial's radiant spokeswoman beckons a once-famous actress now trapped as the mouthpiece of something far darker. As Anya's body changes and her mind unravels, she comes to realize: the product isn't meant to help her. It's meant to consume her.*



# ANYA

*Anya is a highly eccentric young woman whose quest for attention and acceptance. Her unconventional behavior, including wild fashion choices and attention-seeking antics, earned her the nickname "Rainbow" at home but left her isolated at school. Vulnerable to external influences and desperate for validation, Anya becomes entranced by a strange infomercial, leading her into unexpected and potentially risky situations.*

## AVA GONG

Lead Actress

*Ava Gong, a Chicago native whose family immigrated from China in the late 80s, grew up on the South Side where she retained fluency in Cantonese and Taishanese. She pursued theater at Occidental College and also studied education. During her junior year, she taught a theater class to 5th graders in a low-income Los Angeles neighborhood, witnessing their collaborative creativity firsthand. Inspired by this experience, Ava aims to establish a program that encourages youth, particularly from immigrant and low-income backgrounds, to explore storytelling and develop resilience through theater.*

*As the first college graduate in her immediate family, Ava understands the challenges of bridging cultural and generational gaps. Her goal is to empower young voices through art and foster Asian representation in creative industries.*





# WENDY

*Once a rising starlet with a glowing future, Wendy is now the hauntingly serene face of an enigmatic infomercial—her voice promising transformation, beauty, and inner peace through a mysterious product. But behind the screen, Wendy is far from whole. Once celebrated, her career was quietly dismantled by forces that exploit the vulnerable, and in searching for meaning and a second chance, she fell prey to the very system she now represents.*

*Paige Larkowski is an actor from Chicago, IL. She is over the moon to be making her professional debut this season. ## WHY SILK?

*Silk is a surreal satire born from childhood memories of late-night TV ads—psychics, hotlines, and promises of transformation. These moments, though fleeting, left a lasting impression on how we understood identity, desire, and self-worth.*

*The film explores how targeted media and societal ideals shape our sense of self, especially when we're most vulnerable. Through a dreamlike lens, Silk questions the cost of letting external forces define who we are—and whether we ever truly have agency in a world built to sell us something else..*

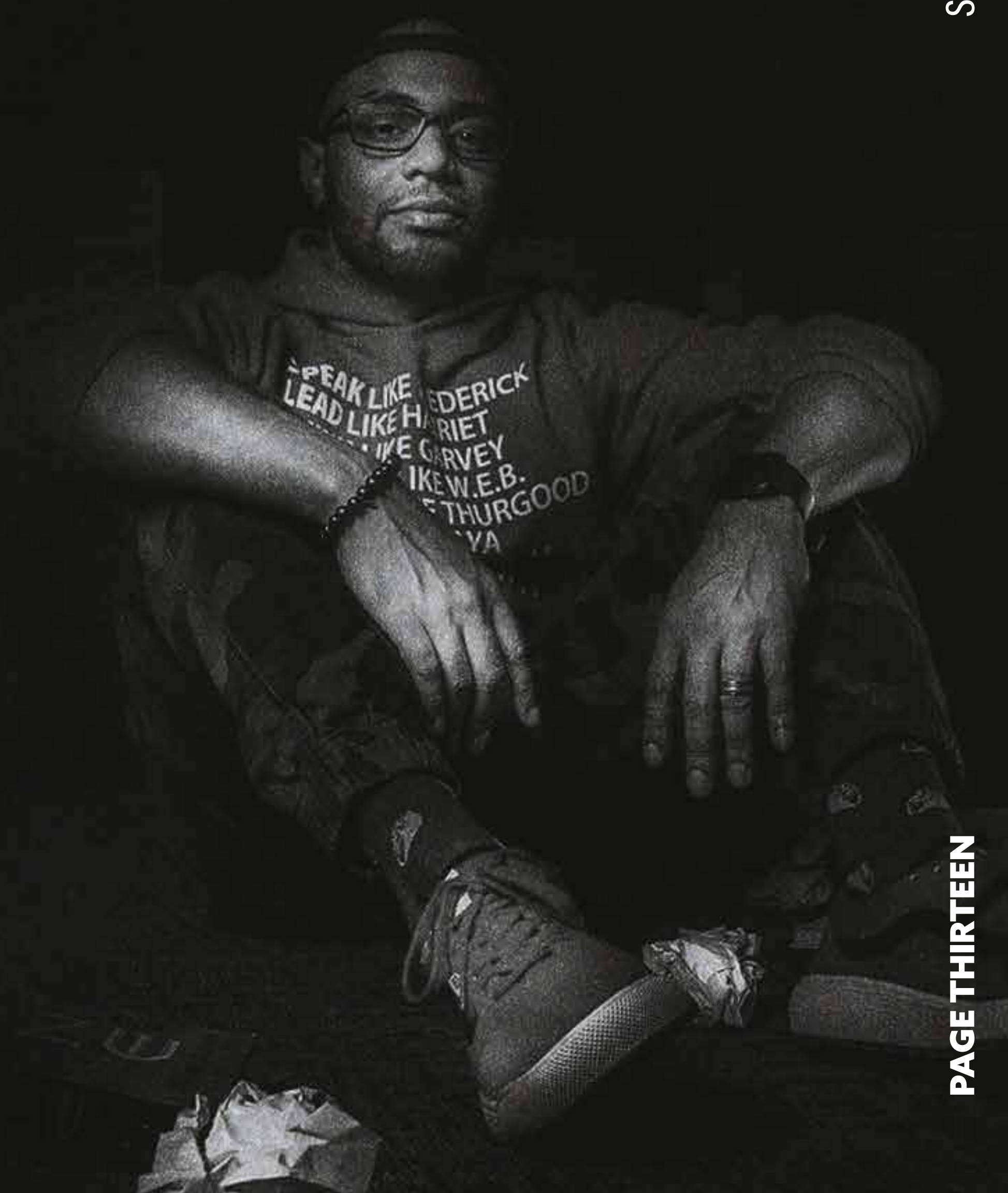


# CHRIS PAICELY
