"Don't Press Delete"

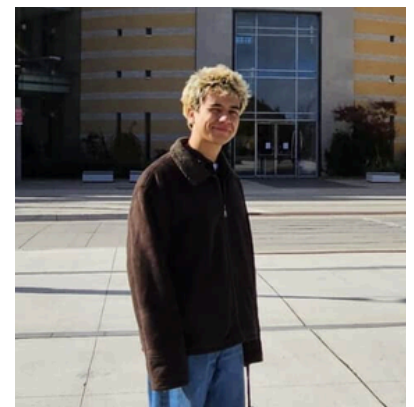

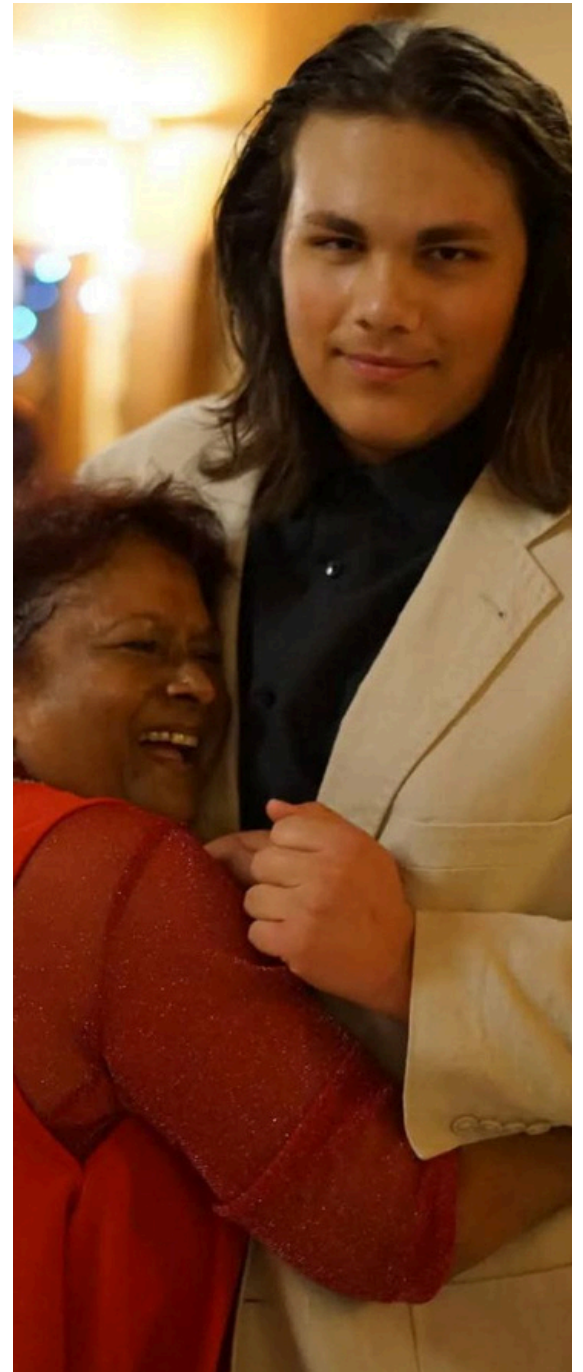

Abbey Scheepers

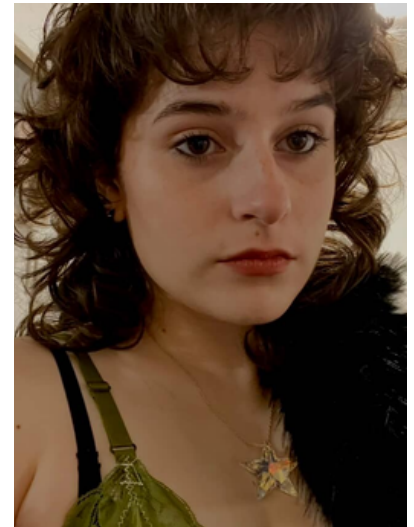
Kenzie

Fallyn Ray

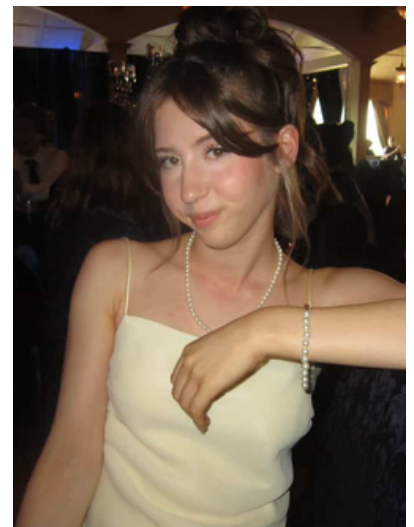
Kayleigh

Aynaz Mohsin

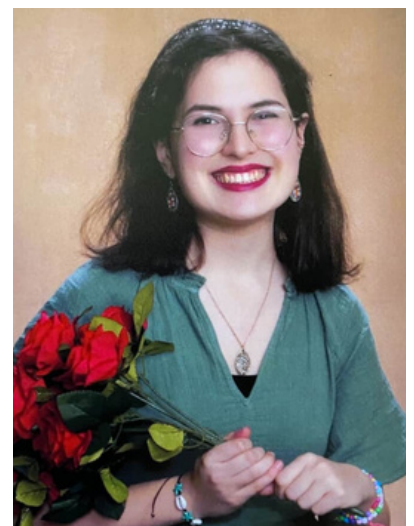
Poster Design
