

SYNOPSIS — La Luminaria – While the Flame Burns

Back in the real world, Ana, Valeria, and Mateo resume their lives with new eyes, learning that healing doesn't mean forgetting, but living with the scars as proof of survival. Years later, when Ana begins to lose herself once more, a soft pink flame — *The Luminaria* — returns to guide her back to her inner light and the child she once was.

In a final act of grace, Ana enters the "Childhood Plane," reliving the innocence she never had, now shared with her daughter. There she understands that true peace is not found by escaping pain, but by remembering who we were — and who we still have the power to become.
