"Ziggy the Raccoon Chef" – 9-Episode Series Plan

Genre: Comedy, Adventure, Cooking

Target Age: 5–14

Episode Duration: ~20 minutes each

Introduction: 📺 **Episode Title: "Welcome to Ziggy's Forest!"**

Duration: ~6–7 minutes

Format: 3D animated, direct-to-camera narration mixed with character vignettes

Tone: Warm, funny, inviting

Goal: Introduce Ziggy and his friends, set tone for the series

📄 **SCREENPLAY: "Welcome to Ziggy's Forest!"**

Scene 1: Forest Clearing – Morning

Visual: Ziggy, a bright-eyed raccoon in a tiny chef's apron, stands in the middle of a cozy woodland kitchen surrounded by trees, birds chirping, sunbeams filtering in.

Ziggy (to camera):

"Hi! I'm Ziggy—raccoon, recipe wrangler, and hopeful head chef of the forest!"

(waves wooden spoon)

"This is my kitchen... kind of. It's a *work in progress*."

Scene 2: Poppy's Entrance

Visual: Tree explodes with gadgets and confetti. A squirrel in goggles rolls in on a steam-powered skateboard.

Ziggy:

"And that's Poppy. Squirrel. Inventor. Chaos machine."

Poppy:

"Wanna see my Banana Cannon 4000?!"

Ziggy (flatly):

"Please... no."

(Cannon goes off anyway. Banana splats.)

Scene 3: Grumbles Stomps In

Visual: Grumbles the bear stomps in, holding a giant ladle, grumbling.

Ziggy:

"That's Grumbles. Big bear. Big frown. Bigger appetite."

Grumbles:

"I don't smile. I fry."
(He does smile slightly at a pie behind him.)

Scene 4: Fern's Forest Elegance

Visual: A deer gently glides in, carrying fresh herbs and flowers.

Ziggy:

"Meet Fern—forest flavor queen and calmest creature alive."

Fern:

"Cooking is like dancing... but with soup."

Ziggy:

"I have no idea what that means. But I love it."

Scene 5: Skitch & Skatch Prank

Visual: Twin foxes swing down from a tree, swapping Ziggy's spoon with a rubber chicken.

Ziggy:

"Those two are Skitch and Skatch. They mean well. They don't act well."

Skatch:

"Who replaced the sugar with salt?"

Skitch:

"...Definitely not us." *(they run off)*

Scene 6: Boo-Boo's Night Arrival

Visual: A bashful bat shyly flutters in upside-down from a branch.

Ziggy:

"This is Boo-Boo. She only cooks at night and speaks in whispers."

Boo-Boo:

"...hi." *(glows faintly in moonlight)*

Ziggy:

"She's the sweetest spooky chef I know."

Scene 7: Mama Maple's Warm Hug

Visual: A cozy squirrel in a floral apron arrives with cinnamon buns.

Ziggy:

"And this is Mama Maple. She bakes hugs. In bun form."

Mama Maple:

"Eat first, talk later, dear."

Ziggy (mouth full):

"Mmmm... okay."

Scene 8: Professor Acorn Descends

Visual: An owl in glasses floats down with a hang glider made of spoons and spaghetti.

Ziggy:

“Professor Acorn. Brain of the forest. Knows things I *definitely* don’t.”

Professor Acorn:

“Did you know soup vibrates at 26.4 giggles per slurp?”

Ziggy:

“See?”

Scene 9: Ziggy Wraps Up

Visual: Ziggy gathers the gang around the big wooden table, dishes everywhere—some burnt, some perfect.

Ziggy (to camera):

“So that’s my team. My forest family. We’re messy, loud, and totally nuts...”

(Skitch drops a nut on Ziggy’s head.)

“...but we cook with heart. And every episode, we’ll serve up stories, snacks, and surprises. So...”

(He puts on a tiny chef’s hat.)

“Ready to cook up some chaos? Let’s go!”

 **End theme jingle plays**

 **On-screen text:** “Subscribe for new adventures with Ziggy every week!”
