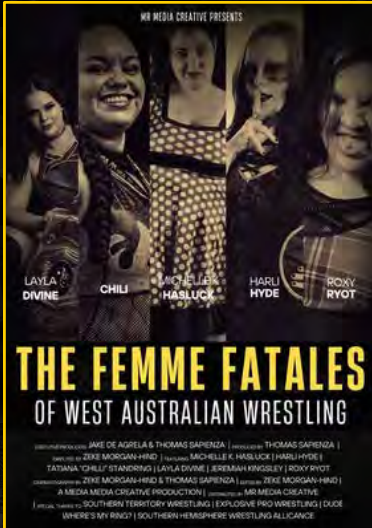

Five trailblazing women step into the ring to challenge tradition and redefine professional wrestling in Western Australia.

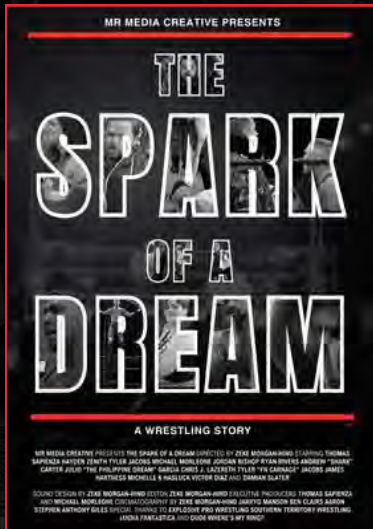
Long Logline

In a scene long dominated by men, *The Femme Fatales of West Australian Wrestling* chronicles the journeys of five pioneering women who fought for respect, representation, and legacy inside the ring. Through triumph, rivalry, sacrifice, and loss, the film reveals how passion and perseverance reshaped an overlooked corner of Australian sport and culture.

In a world where the spotlight has long been dominated by men, five trailblazing women step into the ring to carve out their place in West Australian wrestling history — leaving behind stories of grit, triumph, rivalry, and legacy.

Through the journeys of Chili, Harli Hyde, Layla Divine, Michelle K Hasluck, and Roxy Ryot, this powerful documentary explores the highs and hardships of carving a path in a male-dominated industry. From fearless debuts and promotion-defining clashes to the enduring legacy of Roxy Ryot following her tragic passing, the film captures the blood, sweat, and unshakable spirit of women who changed the game. At its heart, it is not just about wrestling — it is about fighting for recognition, respect, and a place in history.

Short Logline

A lifelong wrestling fan risks everything to transform his dream into reality inside Western Australia's independent wrestling scene.

Long Logline

The Spark of a Dream follows Tom Sapienza as he trains, sacrifices, and endures the brutal realities of professional wrestling in pursuit of his debut. Spanning multiple promotions and communities, the series reveals the passion, discipline, and resilience required to turn fandom into identity and ambition into action.

The Spark of a Dream is an intimate, high-energy documentary series following Tom Sapienza, a lifelong wrestling fan chasing his goal of becoming a professional performer. After four years of training with Explosive Pro Wrestling (EPW), Tom prepares to debut as Tyler Sparks, transforming from spectator to in-ring talent.

Set within Western Australia's diverse wrestling scene, the series explores the disciplined professionalism of EPW, the vibrant multicultural flair of Lucha Fantastica, and the gritty chaos of Dude Where's My Ring. Beyond the spectacle, this is a story of ambition, sacrifice, and community — revealing the human cost and emotional stakes behind every dream realised in the ring.

ABOUT THE DIRECTOR



Zeke Morgan-Hind is a Perth-based filmmaker and media creative whose work fuses documentary and narrative storytelling with a strong focus on identity, resilience, and community. His career spans both social-issue documentaries and character-driven dramas, with projects that have screened across Western Australia and beyond.

Zeke made his directorial debut with the short drama *Faces in the Crowd* (2018), co-directed with Jake De Agrela, followed by *The Unqualified Artist* (2018), a documentary exploring creativity and authenticity within Perth's art scene. He later turned his lens toward social issues with *Unsheltered* (2019), a confronting look at youth homelessness in Perth. His award-winning short film *CRADLE* (2019), along with *The Pretender* (2019) and the comedy road film *Hitched* (2020), showcased his versatility across genres. He also served as First Assistant Director and Editor on Cassandra Power's *Puncture* (2021).

After a brief hiatus, Zeke returned to directing with a renewed focus on long-form storytelling. His work in professional wrestling began with *A Spark of a Dream* (2024–25), a multi-episode documentary series following Tom Sapienza's journey to debut as his persona Tyler Sparks. Immersed in the West Australian wrestling community for over a year, the project reignited Zeke's passion for documentary filmmaking and led to his first feature-length film, *The Femme Fatales of West Australian Wrestling* (2025), which explores the careers and legacies of five pioneering women in the industry.

Since 2023, Zeke has also been teaching Media in a Mandurah-based high school, where he continues to inspire young creatives while pursuing his filmmaking practice. Through his work, he has established himself as one of the few filmmakers dedicated to capturing the untold stories of Australia's independent wrestling scene—blending spectacle with heartfelt storytelling to reveal wrestling as both art form and way of life.

Independent wrestling exists far from the spotlight, yet it demands extraordinary dedication, sacrifice, and resilience. I was drawn to these stories not because of spectacle alone, but because of the people who give everything to their craft with little promise of reward.

Spending over 18 months immersed in Western Australia's wrestling community revealed parallels with every creative pursuit — balancing work, family, identity, and ambition while chasing something deeply personal. These films are about more than wrestling; they are about perseverance, belonging, and the courage to keep showing up when success is uncertain.

*Through *The Spark of a Dream* and *The Femme Fatales of West Australian Wrestling*, my aim is to honour the humanity behind the performance and to document a uniquely Western Australian cultural space rarely captured on screen.*

ABOUT THE PRODUCTION

Both projects were filmed over an 18-month period with extensive behind-the-scenes access to performers, families, trainers, and promotions. Production involved live event coverage, training environments, personal interviews, and emotionally sensitive moments, including injury, loss, and career-defining milestones.

The productions were created in close collaboration with Western Australia's independent wrestling community, ensuring authenticity, trust, and representation.

Episode #1 – Taking Pride

Run Time: 27:37

Thomas Sapienza begins his journey in the West Australian wrestling scene, exploring the dedication and discipline required to pursue his dream. We meet trainers, fellow aspirants, and see the behind-the-scenes preparation that transforms a lifelong fan into a wrestler in training. This episode captures the balance of physical conditioning, character development, and the personal sacrifices that define the first steps toward the spotlight.

Episode #2 – Stepping Up...Down South

Run Time: 31:44

At Southern Territory Wrestling's No Turning Back, we see the next generation of talent showcased through STW's Step Up program. Julio "The Philippine Dream" Garcia reflects on his journey, balancing family, work, and wrestling ambitions. Meanwhile, Tom steps into the ring in a new role as referee for the main event, revealing how every position in wrestling contributes to the shared dream of the community.

Episode #3 – High Flying and Death Defying

Run Time: 26:35

Lucha Fantastica brings colour, athleticism, and high-flying spectacle to the WA wrestling scene, while Dude Where's My Ring pushes the limits of hardcore performance. This episode explores contrasting wrestling styles, from theatrical acrobatics to chaotic extreme matches, highlighting the resilience and creativity required. Through these unique promotions, we see how passion and perseverance define the lives of independent wrestlers beyond the ring.

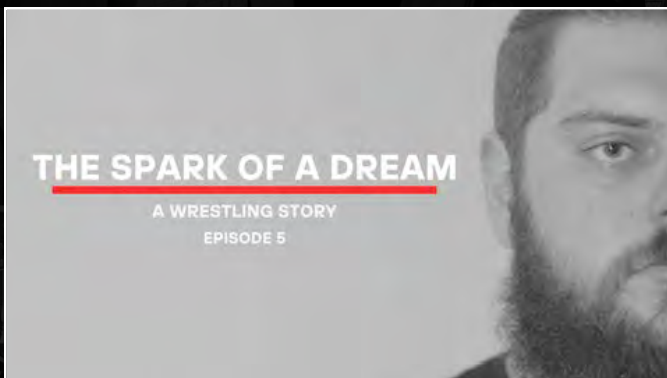


Episode #4 – Blood, Sweat, and Gold

Run Time: 37:28

STW's Ambition III and EPW's ReAwakening 23 mark the biggest nights of the year for WA wrestling. Julio Garcia and Chris Target collide in a bitter feud, while Tyler Jacobs steps into a brutal, blood-soaked retirement match, reflecting on decades in wrestling. At EPW, Hayden Zenith faces CJL in a high-stakes tournament final, showing how ambition and risk intertwine in the pursuit of glory. Every triumph is written in blood, sweat, and gold.

Episode #5 – The Grind

Run Time: 30:04

Tom's journey moves into personal territory as we meet his family and learn the roots of his wrestling dream. He prepares for his training show debut, refining his costume, character, and in-ring skills. Invite-only practice events test his readiness and stamina, while he builds towards EPW's Game Over: Night Two, the self-imposed challenge that has driven a year of sweat, sacrifice, and relentless preparation.

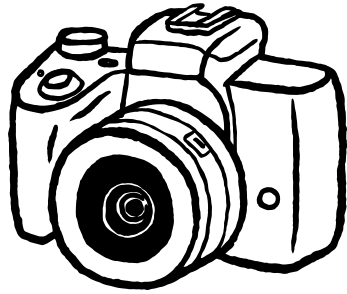


Episode #6 – Breaking Point

Run Time: 20:02

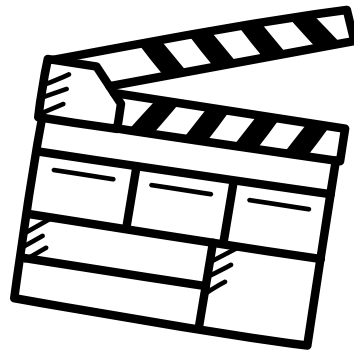
Tom faces the ultimate test at the EPW grading session, overseen by seasoned veteran Damian Slater. As he begins his first storyline with Jordan Bishop, moving from referee to wrestler, the stakes rise. The grading reveals the brutal physical demands of professional wrestling, and just as the dream feels within reach, disaster strikes — leaving Tom's future hanging by a thread and his debut uncertain.
