STATEMENT

Exploitation, in its many forms, is often normalized within the process of artistic creation. Through this film, I aim to explore the darker side of a filmmaker's ambition—how the desire to achieve something great can sometimes clash with the ideals they uphold. I am interested in examining the thin line between sincerity and manipulation, between the urge to “speak about reality” and the temptation to “use reality” for personal gain.

Through the film's protagonist, I seek to ask: how far a creative willing to go to realize their work? And when idealism begins to give way to ambition, can what remains still be called truth, or merely justification?

STATEMENT

In an industry that often celebrates boldness and ambition, we often lack that pause to question the cost of such artistic pursuits—especially when they involve real people and lived experiences. This story, I believe, confronts a tension many artists quietly navigate: the line between creating meaningful work and crossing into exploitation.

The process of this film's creation was a process of engaging with difficult questions on responsibility, authorship, and ethics. At a period when stories are constantly being reshaped and circulated, *Make Sure You Speak Up*, to me, asks us to reconsider not just what we create, but how and why we create it. It is a reminder that urgency in art should never come at the expense of integrity.
