## LOGLINE

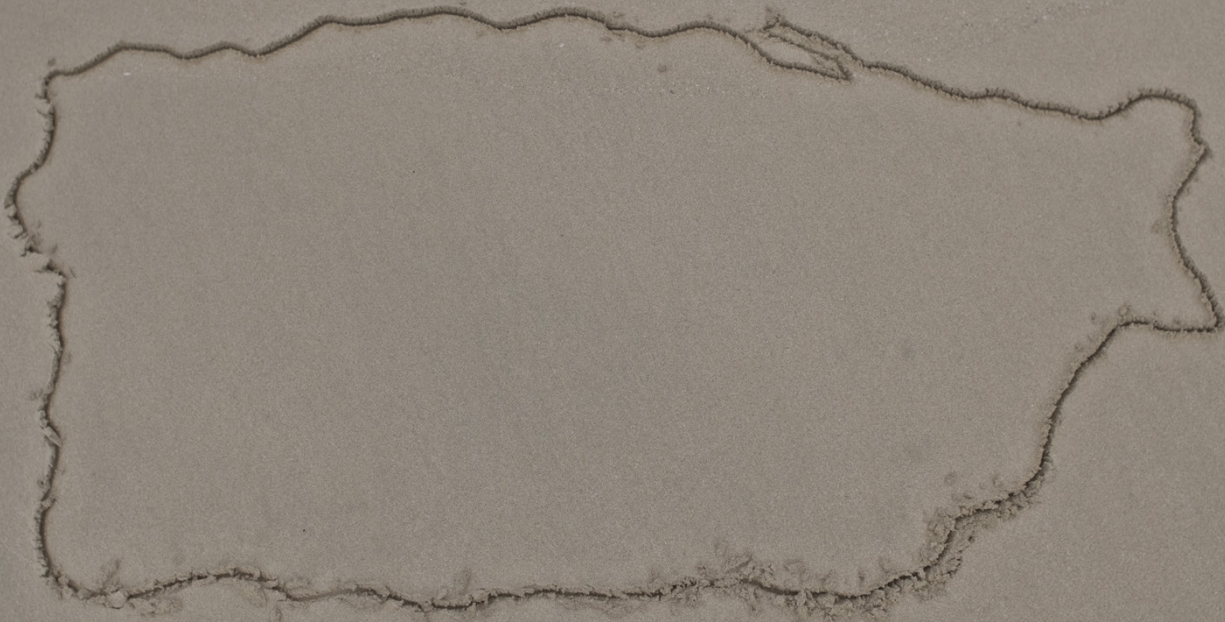
After not wanting to face their problems, Leandro and Lauren arrive at two different beaches and instead face each other through a phenomenon.

---

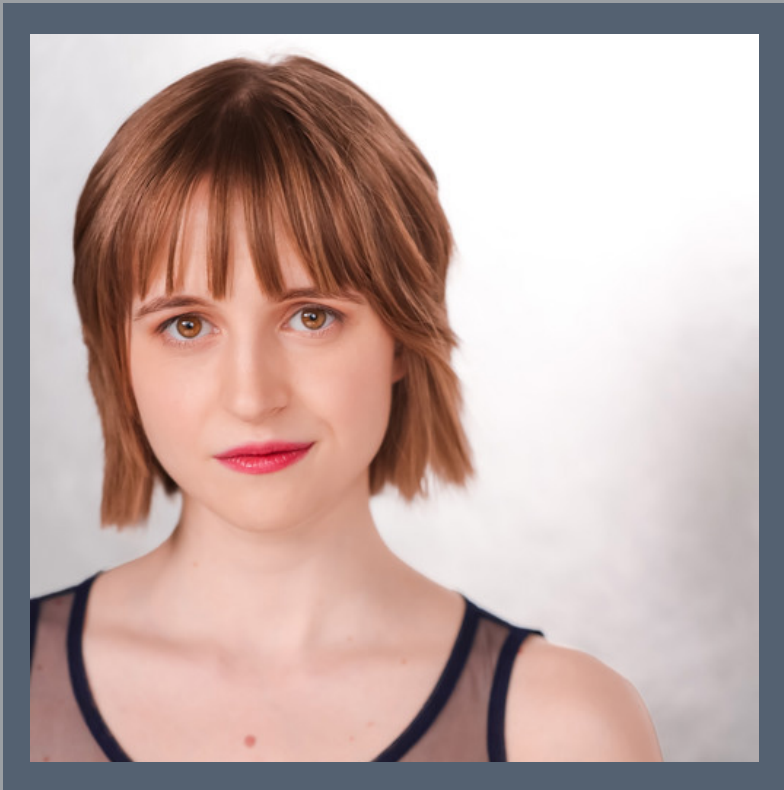
