



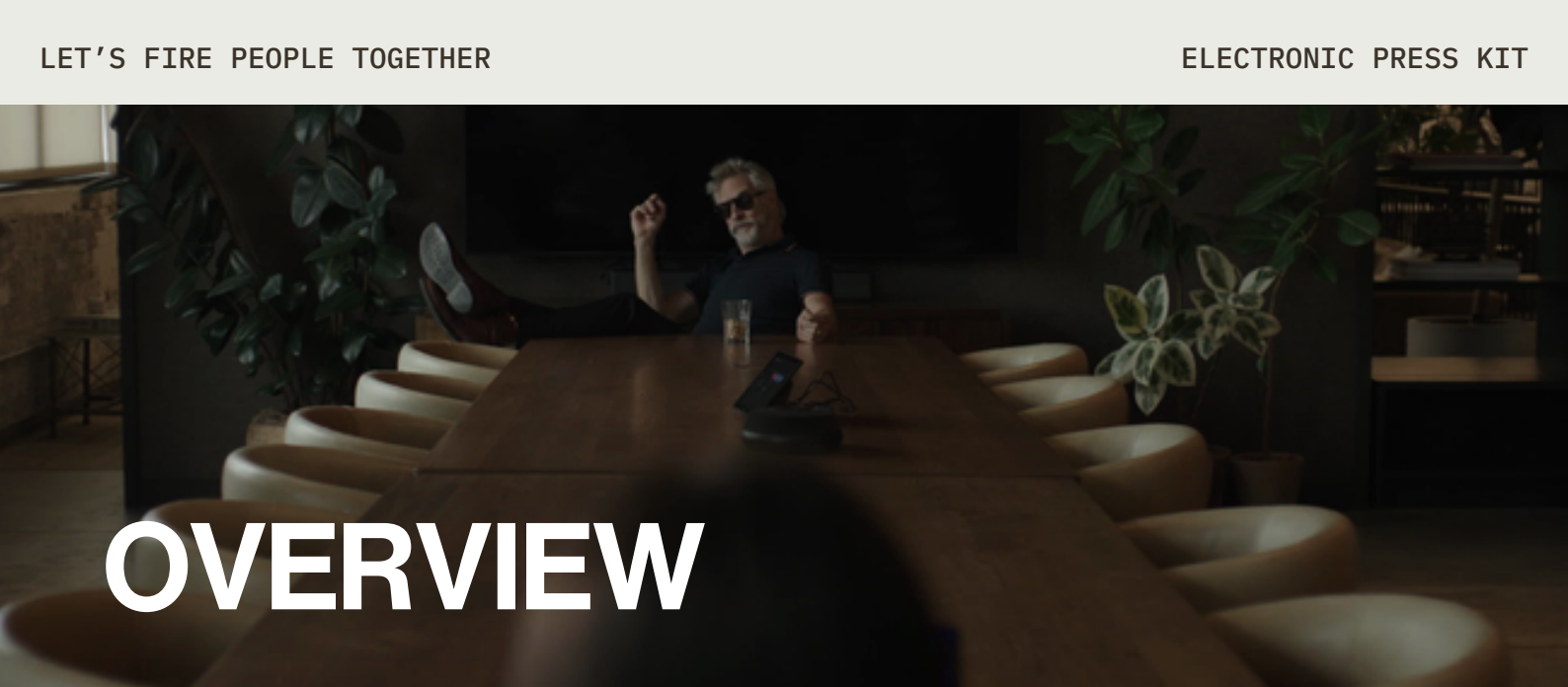

SYNOPSIS

After delivering record results at Dingo, a cutthroat tech startup, Mara expects a long-promised promotion will finally earn her a seat at the table. Instead, she's challenged by the CEO, Ivan, to prove she has “fire” in a culture that treats fear as leadership and empathy as a liability amid AI-driven layoffs.

Mara tries to reconcile her values with the rules of a system that keeps moving the goalposts. When her closest ally ends up on the chopping block, it forces her to decide how much she's willing to trade for advancement, with unexpected consequences.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

When Brennan came to me with the script for Let's Fire People Together, she told me almost every scene came from a conversation she had actually experienced in tech. The script was sharp and funny, but clearly sat on top of something real and lived in. You should laugh, and then feel a little bad that you did.

I felt all of this immensely, because I came from, and still sometimes live in, this corporate world. So much of the film is about trying to break out of the cycle, but also knowing you have to rely on it to pay the bills while keeping the dream alive. I related to that in my own journey of trying to direct my way out of the rat race.

While the subject of AI is in the film, it's not an AI short. It's really about how capitalism's love of efficiency and "making it" leads us to do things we're not proud of and become people we never thought we'd be. This ideal is all too real, and also supremely absurd, and I want to keep making films that poke at those nasty parts of ourselves and our culture.

WRITER'S STATEMENT

“Let’s Fire People Together” began as catharsis. It’s also a real invitation I once got from a person who meant it as a perk.

Several years ago, I was burned out and conflicted about a corporate culture I had never intended to be in, let alone help to sustain: one that treated empathy as a liability and layoffs as routine.

Thankfully I am no longer in that place, but I found myself still trying to make sense of the experience. You can’t hear the words “let’s fire people together” said gleefully and not think about it every time there’s news about layoffs as stocks soar.

AI as a technology gets all the angst and attention, while the people pushing its use rarely do. And sometimes the ones making the call don’t even understand what it can do. They just know it makes shareholder greed sound like “efficiency.” Some of these decisions get made at the top, and some by reasonable everyday people. That’s the part that should scare us.

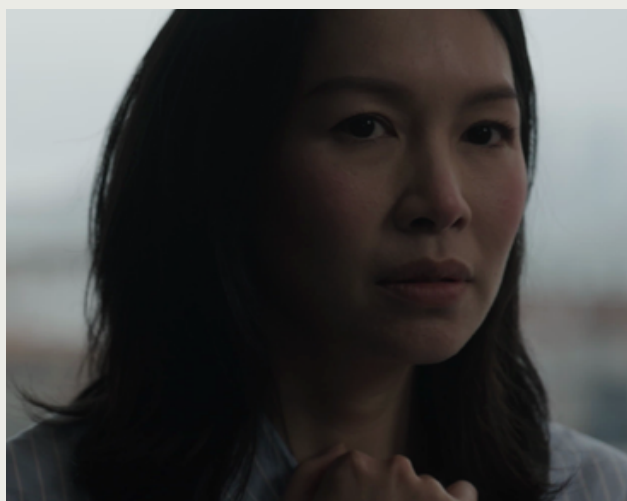
BEN SHAUL
